 DALLAS--JUDGE JOE B. BROWN SAID TODAY HE WOULD RECOMMEND STEPS TO SETTLE THE QUESTION OF CONDEMNED KILLER JACK RUBY'S SANITY AND ASKED DEFENSE AND PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS TO ACCEPT HIS RECOMMENDATIONS. HE DID NOT DISCLOSE DETAILS DURING A CONFERENCE WITH OPPOSING ATTORNEYS IN THE CASE BUT IT WAS BELIEVED HE WOULD CALL FOR IMMEDIATE PSYCHIATRIC TREATMENT OF RUBY EITHER IN HIS JAIL CELL OR IN A DALLAS HOSPITAL. THIS WOULD PUT OFF INDEFINITELY A SANITY HEARING BEFORE A JURY FOR THE 54-YEAR-OLD SLAYER OF ACCUSED PRESIDENTIAL ASSASSIN LEE HARVEY OSWALD.
 DEFENSE ATTORNEY JOE H. TONAHILL OF JASPER, TEX., DEMANDED A SANITY HEARING. HE SAID THAT IF BROWN REFUSED A HEARING, THE DEFENSE WOULD TAKE THE ISSUE TO THE TEXAS SUPREME COURT.
