Oswald Slaying Unplanned, Ruby Says in Lie Test

DALLAS, July 22 (AP).—Jack Ruby told FBI polygraph operators that he had no intention of killing accused presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald until moments before he fired, the Dallar Times-Herald reported today in a copyright story.

ed today in a copyright story. The tests were made last Saturday in the Dallas County jail, where Ruby has been held since shortly alter the slaying of the man accused of assassinating President Kennedy.

vember 24. Ruby told the polygraph (lie detector) operators that he did not help Oswald kill the President, that he was not a member of any organization advocating overthrow of the Government.
