## Ruby Requests Permission to Dump Tonahill

Dallas, Tex., May 24 (AP)—  
 Jack Ruby, convicted of slaying  
 President's Kennedy's assassin,  
 said today he does not want his  
 veteran lawyer, Joe Tonahill, to  
 represent him.

Ruby defended the attempt of

his defense against the wishes of  
 Tonahill.

He said one reason he wished  
 Tonahill removed was because  
 Tonahill took a picture of him in  
 his jail cell after his conviction  
 and, said Ruby, tried to sell it.

The defendant, sentenced to die  
 in the electric chair for killing  
 Lee Harvey Oswald, appeared  
 much the same as he did March  
 14, 1964, when he was convicted  
 and sentenced except that the jail  
 pallor was pronounced.

Oswald killed Kennedy in No-  
 vember, 1963.
