CIVIL RIGHTS.

ON NOVEMBER TWENTYFIVE LAST, DON SULLIVAN, REPORTER FOR THE CHICAGO AMERICAN, TELEPHONICALLY ADVISED THAT HE HAD RECEIVED INFORMATION THAT [REDACTED] OF CHICAGO AND AN ASSOCIATE OF HOODLUMS IN CHICAGO HAD TRAVELLED TO DALLAS, TEXAS, ON NOVEMBER NINETEEN, NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE, AND ON THE FOLLOWING WEDNESDAY TO HOUSTON.

ON NOVEMBER TWENTYSIX INSTANT, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] AND CLOSE ASSOCIATE OF PROMINENT CHICAGO HOODLUM FELIX ALDERISIO, ADVISED SAS JOHN W. ROBERTS, JR., AND AUGUST C. KEMPF THAT HE HAD NO ACQUAINTANCE WITH JACK RUBY AND KNEW NOTHING CONCERNING RUBY EXCEPT THAT WHICH HE READ IN NEWSPAPERS AND SAW ON TELEVISION. [REDACTED] ADMITTED HE TRAVELLED TO DALLAS, TEXAS, ON NOVEMBER NINETEEN, NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE, AND FROM THERE TO HOUSTON ON NOVEMBER TWENTY LAST. HE STATED THAT THESE TRIPS WERE PURELY ON

[REDACTED] BUSINESS AND RUBY WAS IN NO WAY INVOLVED.
