JACK LEON RUBY, AKA/ LEE HARVEY OSWALD, AKA-VICTIM-CR

WILLIAM SLOVER, DETECTIVE, KINGSTON, NEW YORK, POLICE

DEPARTMENT, ADVISED THIS DATE THAT JOSEPH E. SHULER, AGE NINETEEN,  
STAFF ANNOUNCER OF RADIO STATION WKNY, KINGSTON, NEW YORK,

INFORMED HIM THAT AT SEVEN P. M. ON NOVEMBER TWENTY FIVE SIXTYTHREE,  
AN UNIDENTIFIED MALE VOICE TELEPHONICALLY INQUIRED IF JACK RUBY  
HAD YET BEEN SENTENCED. THE INDIVIDUAL WAS ADVISED THIS HAD NOT  
OCCURRED AND INVESTIGATION WAS CONTINUING. UNSUB THEN RELATED HOW  
GREAT PRESIDENT KENNEDY WAS AND REMARKED "WHOEVER SENTENCES  
JACK RUBY WILL BE KILLED". EFFORTS TO HAVE UNSUB IDENTIFY HIMSELF  
WERE UNSUCCESSFUL. UNSUB REMARKED "JACK RUBY DID THE RIGHT THING  
WHEN HE KILLED LEE XXX LEE OSWALD," AND STATED, "I'M LEAVING FOR DALLAS  
TO KILL WHOEVER SENTENCES JACK RUBY." REC-54

SHULER STATED THAT UNSUB WAS A MALE VOICE AND HE GUESSED  
BETWEEN THIRTY AND FIFTY YEARS OF AGE, SLIGHT ACCENT AND POSSIBLY

NEGRO. DICTION WAS GOOD AND VOICE APPEARED EDUCATED. HE SOUNDED AS THOUGH SOBER. SLOVER ADVISED THAT ONLY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION OUT OF KINGSTON IS BUS AND THAT INQUIRY AT THE TWO BUS STATIONS FAILED TO DISCOVER ANYONE INQUIRING CONCERNING SCHEDULES TO DALLAS, TEXAS, OR BUYING TICKETS FOR THAT CITY.
