BACKGROUND ON RUBY.

MR. Y. C. TERRELL, ONE THREE ONE GRAMONT AVENUE, DAYTON, OHIO,
TELEPHONICALLY ADVISED THAT WHILE WATCHING TV ABOUT TWO MONTHS AGO
PERTAINING TO THE TESTIMONY OF JOSEPH VALACHI, VALACHI MENTIONED
SEVERAL UNDERWORLD GANGSTERS IN HIS TESTIMONY, INCLUDING THE NAME OF
RUBENSTEIN. TERRELL RECALLED VALACHI MENTIONED REBENSTEIN WAS RESIDING
IN TEXAS AT THAT TIME. TERRELL COULD FURNISH NO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.
