ON NOV. TWENTYSIX ADVISED THAT DURING WORLD WAR TWO HE WAS BAR
TENDER FOR HIS BROTHER AT BO PEEPS BAR AND POOL ROOM IN SAVANNAH.
RUBY WHO WAS IN THE AIR FORCE STATIONED IN SAVANNAH FOR AN UNKNOWN
PERIOD DURING THE WAR FREQUENTED THE BAR AND ENGAGED HIM IN CON-
VERSATION FREQUENTLY. SOME PERIOD LATER RUBY SENT HIM A CIGARETTE
LIGHTER AS A PRESENT. ABOUT NINETEEN FIFTY FOUR SILVER WENT TO
CHICAGO WITH A FRIEND AND WHILE THERE DECIDED TO LOOK UP RUBY. HE
BELIEVES HE CALLED THE NOVELTY BUSINESS THAT RUBY AND HIS BROTHER
WERE IN BUT FAILED TO REACH EITHER AND WAS TOLD THAT RUBY WAS IN
TEXAS. HE HAS HAD NO OTHER CONTACTS OR KNOWLEDGE OF RUBY. STATES
RUBY WAS QUIET, DIDN/T DRINK ALCOHOL, DIDN/T GAMBLE OR CHASE THE
WOMEN. FIRMLY FEELS THAT RUBY WAS LOYAL AND DESCRIBED HIM AS A GOOD
CLEAN FELLOW. KNEW OF NO HOODLUM OR SUBVERSIVE ASSOCIATIONS.
