MILT SOSIN REPORTER MIAMI DAILY NEWS INTERVIEWED TODAY BY PHONE AT HIS REQUEST, BY SA ROBERT K. LEWIS. HE RELATED FOLLOWING. ON ELEVEN TWENTYFOUR LAST HE AND OTHER REPORTERS PROCEEDED FROM THIRD FLOOR DALLAS MUNICIPAL BUILDING TO BASE-MENT TO OBSERVE TRANSFER OF PRISONER OSWALD. NUMEROUS POLICE OFFICERS FROM SEVERAL ORGANIZATIONS WERE IN BASEMENT AND THEY CAREFULLY EXAMINED PRESS CARDS, DEPT. OF DEFENSE CARDS, AND OTHER IDENTIFYING CARDS CARRIED BY MEMBERS OF PRESS. HE DESCRIBES THE SECURITY AS VERY GOOD AND SAYS HIS DOD CARD CHECKED SEVERAL TIMES BY OFFICERS. SOSIN BEING A STRANGER IN DALLAS WAS NOT ACQUAINTED WITH EVERYONE AND DOES NOT KNOW OF ANY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS PRESENT OTHER THAN RUBY. SAYS APPARENTLY POLICE WERE SO USE TO SEEING RUBY HE WAS ACCEPTED AS A BELONGER OR QUOTE PART OF SCENERY UNQUOTE. HE NEVER TALKED WITH RUBY AND HAS NO KNOWLEDGE ANY CONSPIRACY BETWEEN RUBY AND POLICE. DOES NOT BELIEVE THERE WAS ANY ASSOICATION BETWEEN RUBY AND OSWALD AS RUBY APPARENTLY WAS PRACTICALLY BERSERK OVER **REC 14** KENNEDYS DEATH.
