CIVIL RIGHTS

Mr. Malley telephonically advised this date that a lead was received by Dallas to trace a Western Union money order which was allegedly sent by Ruby to a female on Sunday morning.

Dallas has advised this female is Karan Bennett. She was interviewed and stated that she had attempted to obtain money from Ruby Saturday evening as he did not have it at that time. She stated that Ruby did send her a money order on Sunday.

Mr. Malley stated the only way information can be obtained from Western Union at this time would be in the manner of a subpoena duces tecum. The U. S. Attorney is willing to prepare such a subpoena. However, Mr. Malley advised against it in view of Ruby's arrest by local authorities in connection with the murder of Oswald. No further action will be taken by the Dallas Office in this regard, UACB.

Regarding the gun used by Ruby, Mr. Malley stated that Dallas verified the place where it was purchased. The above is to be confirmed by teletype this date.
