At 7:28 P.M., 11-29-63, SA Ken Grant, Chicago Office, was telephonically contacted and referenced to Chicago teletype to Bureau and Dallas 11-25-63, 8:03 P.M., in captioned matter which sets forth results of interviews with two individuals in the Chicago area who reported having seen and talked to Ruby on Labor Day weekend, 1959, at Havana, Cuba.

It was pointed out that in the interview with Sherwin Jack Braun, it is not specifically set forth as to whether Braun was able to identify a photograph of Ruby as the person Braun saw over Labor Day weekend in Havana. Chicago is requested to clarify this point. Also, no lead was set forth in Chicago to interview Jack Marcus, an individual who accompanied Braun and Jay Bishov to Cuba in 1959 and who also may have seen Ruby.

SA Grant was advised these leads should be followed promptly and the Bureau advised by teletype.
