QUOTE ASSISTANT TO THE COMMISSIONER OF NARCOTICS GEORGE GAFFNEY TELEPHONICALLY ADVISED THE UNDERSIGNED ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER TWENTYSIX, NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE, THAT IN THE COURSE OF A SEARCH OF THEIR FILES IN A CASE OF THEIRS REFLECTED THAT IN NINETEEN FORTYSEVEN THEY WERE ADVISED BY CUSTOMS THAT WERE INVOLVED IN THE ACT OF

CUSTOMS ASKED NARCOTICS IN CHICAGO SMUGGLING OPIUM IN MEXICO. AND JACK RUBY AT THE CONGRESS HOTEL TO ASCERTAIN IF THEY WERE INVOLVED WITH THE MEETING BETWEEN AND JACK RUBY WAS ARRANGED BY WHO OPERATED THE SINGAPORE CLUB.
