CIVIL RIGHTS

During the current investigation of captioned individual, individuals have been interviewed who state they met Ruby in Havana, Cuba, some time in 1959. Two of these persons believe it was during the Labor Day weekend of 1959, however, investigation had not further pinpointed the date Ruby may have been there.

The New York Office has advised that microfilm records of the Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) have been reviewed at New York in an effort to obtain further information concerning Ruby's travel to Cuba. These records reflect that one Jack Ruby, 4722 Homer, Dallas, Texas, left Miami, Florida, on 9/12/59 aboard Pan American Airlines, Flight 415, bound for Havana, Cuba.

New York is continuing efforts at the INS Microfilm Center New York City to locate any record of Ruby's return to the U.S.A.
