On November 30, 1963, ROBERT MULLER, Chief Deputy Sheriff, Jim Wells County, Texas, advised that he had been informed that JACK RUBY was a member of a hunting party shortly after the opening of the season on November 16, 1963, at the ranch of BUCK SUEAR, a well-known Mason, Texas rancher. On November 30, 1963, Mr. LEE SHEARER, owner of the Oak Grove Ranch, 14 miles east of Mason, Texas, and also of a ranch called the San Saba Ranch, 5 miles north of Pontotoc, Texas, advised that he leases the San Saba Ranch to six hunters from Dallas, Texas. He said that JACK LEON RUBY was not one of the lessors and so far as he knew RUBY had never hunted on his ranch. He pointed out that he did not know that any of the legitimate lessors had ever brought a guest to hunt as this would not be permitted under the lease.
