H. R. HIEMAN, JR., retired U. S. Navy Admiral, Executive Director, Texas State Building Commission, Austin, Texas, home address 4700 Balcones Drive, advised SA DAVID G. LOVELESS on 12/4/63 as follows:

NIEMAN in the early 1950s was Commanding Officer of the Naval Air Station in Dallas, Texas. He recalls that a young Naval officer, CHARLES LEON NAGLE, during 1951 was found in an unconscious state at the foot of some stairs leading from the Colonial Club, a night spot in Dallas, NAGLE was hospitalized and NIEMAN conducted an investigation.

The assassination of President KENNEDY and subsequent murder by JACK RUBY caused HIEMAN to recall the incident. He believes that RUBY was working at/or Hanager of the Colonial Club at the time of above incident and that this club's present name is the Carousel Club. NIEMAN feels if NAGLE is interviewed he could furnish information re RUBY's character.
