At 3:25 p.m. Duty Agent Sidney H. Neel, Jr., of the Chicago Office was telephonically contacted with reference to the article by "Star" staff writer Jerry O'Leary, Jr., which appeared in the 12-1-63 issue of the "Evening Star." This article stated in part, "Ruby returned to Chicago and for a time frequented gambling spots with a man named Nathan Gumbin until Gumbin was killed in a gangland assassination."

SA Neel was instructed to determine: (1) Who was Gumbin and what were the circumstances of his death; (2) Whether we know of any association between Ruby and Gumbin.
