deceased husband attended four meetings at an unknown apartment
in Dallas, the purpose of which was to arrange to send Enfield
rifles to Castro in Cuba. She stated Jack Ruby was present at
three of these meetings.

Perrin furnished a signed statement containing the above
information on 12/3/63. She also furnished a signed waiver of
consent to be interviewed with the polygraph. She has a nervous
disorder, St. Vitus Dance, which she feels may affect the polygraph,

for Dallas concerning this information, including the interviews of
individuals who knew Perrin in order to establish her reliability.
