RE BUREAU TEL TO NEW YORK TWELVE THREE SIXTYTHREE, FIVE ZERO FOUR PM, CONCERNING TELEGRAM RECEIVED AT THE BUREAU, DEC. THREE, NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE, FROM JAY W. DE YOUNG, NYC. DE YOUNG INTERVIEWED TWELVE FIVE AT NYC AND HE INDICATED THAT NEWSPAPER REPORTS INDICATED ONE JACOB RUBENSTEIN WAS IN THE AMERICANA HOTEL IN NOV. PRIOR TO THE PRESIDENT-S ARRIVAL TO ADDRESS LABOR CONVENTION AT THIS HOTEL.

RECORDS OF AMERICANA HOTEL ON TWELVE SIX, FAILED TO REFLECT ANY REGISTRATION FOR JACK RUBENSTEIN IN NOVEMBER, NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE. REGISTRATION WAS LOCATED FOR S. J. RUBINSTEIN, PO BOX SIX EIGHT SEVEN, DALLAS, TEXAS, WHO INDICATED HE REPRESENTED RUBENSTEIN FOODS AND REMAINED AT THE HOTEL FROM FOUR THIRTY TO FIVE FIVE NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE.

DALLAS DETERMINE IF PO BOX SIX EIGHT SEVEN WAS LISTED TO SUBJ, RUBY.
