TWENTY SEVEN THAT HE NEVER MET AND DID NOT KNOW JACK LEON  
RUBY. CARACI RECALLED THAT IN ABOUT JUNE, SIXTY THREE,  
RUBY CAME TO CLUB FIVE HUNDRED AND TALKED TO HIS NIGHT  
MANAGER, CLEEVE DUGAS, ABOUT SECURING DANCERS TO WORK  
FOR HIM. CARACI WAS BUSY AND TOLD DUGAS TO TELL RUBY TO  
GO TO THE SHO- BAR CLUB AND TALK TO JEANETTE CONFORTO WHO WAS  
ABOUT TO COMPLETE HER ENGAGEMENT.
