Re Dallas teletype 2:01 p.m., 11/30/63, concerning interview with JAMES EUGENE FLOYD, JR., Texas Dept. of Corrections #172555, who had advised prison authorities he was acquainted with RUBY and that RUBY had offered him \$5,000 to kill Gov. CONNALLY. The Bureau was advised that FLOYD, while in the U. S. Army, was held under observation as a possible "psycho".

FLOYD was interviewed exhaustively and maintained his same story. An authorized polygraph test was given following which FLOYD admitted his story was a fabrication, claiming that he wanted "to get even" with RUBY whom he suspected of having unnatural sex relations with FLOYD's wife. The Bureau has been advised of the results of the polygraph test by separate communication.

Two copies of an interview with FLOYD are transmitted herewith to the Bureau and the original will be maintained in Dallas file. Also enclosed are 2 copies of an insert prepared in Dallas on the basis of information supplied by the Houston Office.
