QUESTION ONE/ SHERIFF/BILL DECKER, DALLAS SO, ADVISED
TO HIS KNOWLEDGE THERE IS NO STATE LAW GOVERNING TRANSFERRING
OF PRISONERS FROM THE DALLAS CITY JAIL TO THE DALLAS COUNTY
JAIL. DECKER STATES ESTABLISHED PROCEDURE IS AS FOLLOWS/

WHEN CHARGES FILED WITH COURT OF JURISDICTION, UPON
ISSUANCE OF WARRANT TO PROPER AUTHORITY, PRISONER THEN BECOMES
SUBJECT TO TRANSFER TO THE COUNTY JAIL WITHIN A REASONABLE
TIME.

THE CONSTABLES OF ALL JUSTICE COURTS IN WHICH ALL
FELONY CASES ORIGINATE, UPON ISSUANCE OF A WARRANT TO THEM
MAY TRANSFER PRISONERS FROM THE CITY JAIL TO THE COUNTY
JAIL. IF WARRANT ISSUED BY THE JP WITHIN THE COUNTY,

THE SHERIFF OR APPROPRIATE CONSTABLE COULD SERVE PROCESS AND REMOVE SUBJECT FROM THE CITY JAIL TO THE COUNTY JAIL. DALLAS PD CAN ALSO REMOVE PRISONERS FROM DALLAS CITY JAIL TO THE DALLAS COUNTY JAIL.

COMPLAINT CHARGING OSWALD WITH MURDER OF LATE PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY FILED BY CAPT. WILL FRITZ, DL PD, AT ELEVEN THIRTY FIVE PM, NOV. TWENTYTWO, LAST.

SHERIFF DECKER STATED WITH REGARD TO HIS KNOWLEDGE OF PLANNED REMOVAL OF OSWALD BY DALLAS PD FROM CITY JAIL TO DALLAS COUNTY JAIL, THAT ALL DURING THE DAY OF NOV. TWENTYTHREE LAST HE HAD HEARD RUMORS FROM NEWS MEDIA THAT OSWALD WAS TO BE REMOVED NOV. TWENTYTHREE. SOMEONE CALLED FROM DL PD ON NOV. TWENTYTHREE SIXTYTHREE, MAYBE CPT. J. W. FRITZ, AND INDICATED QUESTIONING OF OSWALD WAS NOT QUITE COMPLETED, BUT REMOVAL MIGHT BE THAT DAY. DECKER STATED HE TOLD HIM THAT HE WOULD MAKE NECESSARY SECURITY CHECK OF A CELL FOR OSWALD. ABOUT SIX PM, NOV. TWENTYTHREE DECKER HEARD FROM SOME SOURCE THAT THE TIME OF REMOVAL FOR OSWALD HAD BEEN SET FOR TEN AM NOV. TWENTYFOUR. DECKER STATED HE HAD HIS OFFICE CONFIRM FROM DALLAS PD THAT THIS WAS TRUE. DECKER DOES NOT RECALL WHO CONFIRMED THIS FOR HIM.

DECKER STATED ON MORNING OF NOV. TWENTYFOUR CHIEF CURRY DALLAS PD CALLED AND SAID HE WAS GOING TO USE AN ARMORED TRUCK TO MOVE OSWALD AND WANTED TO KNOW WHAT DECKER THOUGHT ABOUT IT. DECKER STATED HE TOLD CHIEF CURRY THAT IT WOULD BE UP TO CURRY TO MAKE DECISION ON THIS. DALLAS SHERIFF/S OFFICE HAD NO PLANS FOR PARTICIPATING IN REMOVAL UNTIL OSWALD DELIVERED TO COUNTY JAIL.

QUESTION NO. TWO, RUBY/S DALLAS PD NO. IS THREE SIX THREE NINE EIGHT.

QUESTION NO. THREE/ J. M. CHANEY, MOTOR CYCLE PATROLMAN, DL PD, STATES IN FD THREE ZERO TWO HAS KNOWN RUBY CASUALLY FOR YEARS AS A CLUB OWNER, BUT HAS NO SOCIAL OR BUSINESS CONTACT. CHANEY ON DUTY AT ASSASSINATION SCENE AFTERNOON, NOV. TWENTY THIRD. RUBY WAS PRESENT AS SPECTATOR AND TALKED TO CHANEY ABOUT ASSASSINATION. HE APPEARED SOLEMN AS DID EVERYONE ELSE.

QUESTION NO. FOUR. BUAGENTS OBSERVED OSWALD BEING TRANSFERRED FROM HOMICIDE BUREAU, THIRD FLOOR, TO ASSEMBLY ROOM IN BASEMENT WHERE PRESS CONFERENCE WAS HELD NIGHT OF NOV. TWENTYTWO LAST. HENRY WADE, DA, VERIFIED IN INTERVIEW THAT HE HAD ARRANGED FOR REPORTERS TO INTERVIEW OSWALD AT THIS PRESS CONFERENCE NIGHT OF

QUESTION NO. FIVE. LT. JAMES R. GILMORE,

IN INTERVIEW NOV. TWENTYFIVE LAST, STATES SAW RUBY IN BASEMENT, DALLAS POLICE AND COURTS BUILDING, ON NIGHT NOV. TWENTYTWO LAST. ON FIRST MEETING WAS APPROXIMATELY MIDNIGHT IN VICINITY OF POLICE ASSEMBLY ROOM WHERE DA HENRY WADE HOLDING PRESS CONFERENCE. AT THAT TIME, RUBY TOLD GILMORE

HE HAD DISTRIBUTED SANDWICHES TO THE KLIF RADIO STATION EMPLOYEES WHO WERE IN BUILDING. SECOND OBSERVANCE WAS SEVERAL MINUTES LATER IN CORRIDOR NEAR PD RECORDS BUREAU IN BUILDING BASEMENT, NO CONVERSATION. IN RUBY INTERVIEW, RUBY STATED HE CALLED DETECTIVE RICHARD M. SIMS AFTER PURCHASE OF SANDWICHES TO SEE IF ANYONE WANTED THEM. SIMS ADVISED SANDWICHES NOT NEEDED. SIMS OUT OF CITY UNTIL FOUR PM NOV. TWENTYNINE, NEXT XXX NEXTWHEREABOUTS NOT KNOWN. NO CONTACT KLIF TO VERIFY DISTRIBUTION OF SANDWICHES.

QUESTION NO. SIX, RUBY, IN INTERVIEW NOV. TWENTYFIVE LAST BY BUAGENT, STATED IN ACTIVITIES ON NIGHT NOV. TWENTYTWO LAST WENT TO A DELICATESSEN /IDENTIFIED AS PHIL/S DELICATESSEN,

DALLAS/ WHERE HE HAD SANDWICHES MADE UP WITH INTENT OF GIVING SAME TO OFFICERS OF DALLAS PD. SANDWICHES REFUSED BY DALLAS PD ACCORDING TO RUBY.

TWO WITNESSES LOCATED WHO ADVISED SEEING RUBY AT PHIL/S DELICATESSEN ON LATE EVENING NOV. TWENTYTWO. /SEE QUESTION NO. FIVE ABOVE RE ALLEGED DISPOSITION OF SANDWICHES.

QUESTION NO. NINE, OFFICER L. C. MULLENAX, VICE SQUAD, SPECIAL SERVICES BUREAU, DALLAS PD, WHILE ON UNDERCOVER ASSIGNMENT, WAS SHOT AND KILLED LATE PM FEB. TEN SIXTYTHREE, OR EARLY AM FEB. ELEVEN, SIXTYTHREE, BY ONE HARRY PADDY RHYAN, OPERATOR SHERMAN HOTEL, DALLAS, TEX. THIS MATTER PRESENTED TO DALLAS COUNTY GRAND JURY AND NO BILL RETURNED AS TO RHYAN ON CHARGE OF MURDER, MAY TWENTYNINE, SIXTYTHREE.

ABOVE INCIDENT PERSONALLY RECALLED BY AGENTS, DALLAS OFFICE. AT TIME OF INCIDENT, OFFICER MULLENAX WAS IN COMPANY OF KNOWN DALLAS POLICE CHARACTER AND A PROSTITUTE WITH WHOM HE ENTERED HOTEL AND BECAME INVOLVED IN LOUD ARGUMENT IN HOTEL CORRIDOR. RHYAN, IN EFFORT TO QUIET MULLENAX AND OTHERS, WAS THREATENED WITH BODILY HARM BY MULLENAX AND REPORTEDLY IN SELF-DEFENSE, SHOT AND KILLED MULLENAX. MULLENAX WAS NOT THEN KNOWN TO BE

AN OFFICER OF THE DALLAS PD BY RHYAN. THESE CIRCUMSTANCES WERE BASIS FOR NO BILL.

QUESTION TEN, LT. VERNON S. SMART, AUTO THEFT DETAIL DALLAS PD, STATES ON BASIS OF INFORMATION FURNISHED HIM BY ASSISTANT CHIEF OF POLICE M. W. STEVENSON WHO APPARENTLY OBTAINED HIS INFORMATION FROM CAPT. WILL FRITZ, HOMICIDE BUREAU, WHO HAD TALKED TO RUBY, SMART LOCATED RUBY/S SIXTY OLDS. AT ALLRIGHT PARKING LOT, CORNER MAIN AND PEARL STREETS, ACROSS STREET FROM WESTERN UNION BUILDING, NEAR DALLAS PD. TEXAS

QUESTION NO. ELEVEN, RAY BRANTLEY, PROPRIETOR RAY/S HARDWARE STORE, ADVISED RUBY PURCHASED POINT THIRTYEIGHT COLT COERA HIMSELF AND THAT GUN PURCHASED IN RUBY/S NAME. RUBY GAVE ADDRESS OF THIRTYFIVE ZERO EIGHT OAKLAWN, WHICH IS THE ADDRESS OF THE VEGAS CLUB. BRANTLEY DID NOT KNOW RUBY WHEN GUN WAS PURCHASED IN NINETEEN SIXTY. SINCE THEN HAS HAD REPEATED BUSINESS CONTACTS WITH HIM. HE HAS SEEN PHOTOGRAPHS OF RUBY AND DEFINITELY IDENTIFIES RUBY AS MAN HE SOLD GUN TO. TENN

QUESTION NO. FOURTEEN, CAPT. WILL FRITZ IN THREE ZERO TWO STATES HE DID NOT KNOWN RUBY.

QUESTION NO. FIFTEEN, ASSISTANT CHIEF OF POLICE M. W. END PAGE SIX

STEVENSON ADVISES THREE PERSONS, AS FOLLOWS, WERE EJECTED FROM AREA PRIOR TO BRINGING OSWALD INTO GARAGE AREA AND WHERE SHOT/ BILLY RICHER AND HAROLD R. FUGUA, BOTH NEGRO POLICE GARAGE ATTENDANTS, AND GEORGE T. CHABOT, EMPLOYEE OF CITY WHOSE WIFE IS POLICEWOMAN. THESE PERSONS NOT YET INTERVIEWED. THEY WILL BE INTERVIEWED.

QUESTION SEVENTEEN. DETECTIVE T. D. MC MILLAN, AUTO THEFT BUREAU, DALLAS PD, ADVISED THAT CAPTAIN WILL FRITZ CAME OUT OF THE JAIL OFFICE DOOR AT ELEVEN TWENTYFIVE AM AND ASKED IF EVERYTHING WAS ALL RIGHT. MC MILLAN SAID THAT HE ANSWERED "YES SIR". MC MILLAN SAID CAPTAIN FRITZ HAD PROCEEDED PAST HIM, AND THE TWO HOMICIDE DETECTIVES WITH THE PRISONER HAD JUST PASSED HIM, MC-MILLAN. DETECTIVE MC MILLAN SAID AS THE PRISONER WAS EVEN WITH HIM, MC MILLAN, HE, MC MILLAN, MADE A LEFT FACE, WHICH CAUSED HIM, MC MILLAN, TO BE WALKING IN A SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION. MC MILLAN RELATED THAT AS HE HAD TAKEN ABOUT ONE OR TWO STEPS IN FORMING THE BARRIER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE PRISONER A MAN JUMPED FROM SOMEWHERE SLIGHTLY TO HIS, MC MILLAN/S RIGHT AND IN FRONT OF MC MILLAN. MC MILLAN SAID THAT HE HEARD THIS MAN SAY "YOU RAT, SON - - BITCH, YOU SHOT THE PRESIDENT". MC MILLAN SAID

QUESTION NO. EIGHTEEN, RALPH PAUL, AKA RALPHEAL PAUL, OWNER OF BULL PEN RESTAURANT, ARLINGTON, TEXAS, ADVISES CAROUSEL CLUB, DALLAS, OWNED BY S AND R, INC, OF WHICH HE OWNS FIFTY PER CENT AND IN WHICH RUBY HAS AN INTEREST.

RECORDS OF SPECIAL SERVICES BUREAU, DALLAS PD, REFLECT APPLICATION FOR LICENSE SHOWS OWNERSHIP BY S AND R, INC., RALPH PAUL, PRESIDENT, JACK RUBY, VICE-PRESIDENT, AND BROTHER SAMUEL RUBY, SECRETARY-TREASURER. ADDITIONAL CHECK TO DETERMINE OWNERS OF ADDITIONAL FIFTY PER CENT BEING MADE. *Texas*

QUESTION NO. NINETEEN, EVA GRANT, RUBY/S SISTER, CONTINUES AS MANAGER VEGAS CLUB. SHE HAD MAJOR SURGERY ON NOV. SEVEN LAST AND DISCHARGED FROM HOSPITAL NOV. FOURTEEN LAST. IN HER ABSENCE, PAULINE HALL ASSUMED DUTIES AS MANAGER ON NOV. FIFTH LAST AND CONTINUES AS SUCH ONLY UNTIL GRANT/S RETURN FOLLOWING RECOOPERATION. *Texas*
