JACK LEON RUBY, AKA., LEE HARVEY OSWALD, AKA DASH VICTIM,
DECEASED, CR. RESFTEL NOVEMBER TWENTY SIX CONCERNING
AUBRYE DE PELLATON AND BUTELCALL TO SF SAME DATE.

RE RECENT POSSIBLE TRAVEL OF RUBY. DE PELLATON GIVEN
POLYGRAPH EXAMINATION AT SAN FRANCISCO NOVEMBER TWENTY SIX.
EXAMINER OF OPINION DE PELLATON NOT TELLING A DELIBERATE
FALSEHOOD AND THAT AN INCIDENT WITH SOME PERSON HIRING HIS
CAB OCCURRED AS DESCRIBED BY HIM. HOWEVER, DE PELLATON
ADVISED HE SUFFERED SEVERE HEAD INJURY IN AUTO ACCIDENT IN
NINETEEN FIFTYONE, RESULTING IN TEMPORARY LOSS OF MEMORY AND
AS GIVEN ELECTROENCEPHALOGRAM TESTS IN CONNECTION WITH HIS
HOSPITALIZATION. CLAIMS NO CURRENT MEMORY DEFECTS AND STATES
HE IS POSITIVE THE PASSENGER TOLD HIM HIS NAME WAS JACK RUBY.
NOW STATES HE DEFINITELY FIXES THE TIME AS SHORTLY AFTER
EVEN PM NOVEMBER TWENTY LAST. IN VIEW HIS MEDICAL HISTORY

THE POSSIBILITY MUST BE CONSIDERED HE MAY BE CONFUSED WITH RESPECT
TO THE NAME. HE SAID HE COULD NOT IDENTIFY RUBY-S PHOTOGRAPH.
WILL ATTEMPT TO OBTAIN CORROBORATION HIS STORY. DALLAS ADVISE
IF ANY INFORMATION AVAILABLE POSITIVELY PLACING RUBY IN DALLAS AT TIME OF
ALLEGED INCIDENT.
