ACQUAINTANCES-

ON DECEMBER FOUR, INSTANT, SA FORD E. HOLMES CONTACTED ROBERT STUART, AKA BUDDY KING, AT VETERANS HOSPITAL, RENO, NEVADA. STUART ADVISED HE WORKED FOR JACK RUBY AT DALLAS FOR THREE OR FOUR MONTHS IN THE LATE SUMMER AND FALL OF NINETEEN SIXTYONE AS MANAGER AND MASTER OF CEREMONIES OF THE CARROUSEL CLUB. HE SAID WHEN HE FIRST WORKED FOR RUBY THE CLUB WAS KNOWN AS THE SOVEREIGN CLUB AND IT WAS A PRIVATE CLUB. WHEN RUBY OBTAINED A LIQUOR LICENSE THE NAME WAS CHANGED TO THE CARROUSEL CLUB AND IT BECAME AN OPEN NIGHT CLUB. STUART KNOWS OF NO CRIMINAL ASSOCIATES OF RUBY OR ANY COMMUNIST SYMPATHIES ON THE PART OF RUBY. HE SAID RUBY HATEL COMMUNISTS AND BITTERLY DENOUNCED THEM ON OCCASIONS. STUART DOES NOT

KNOW LEE HARVEY OSWALD AND KNEW OF NO ASSOCIATION BETWEEN RUBY AND OSWALD. STUART SAID HE HAS NOT SEEN RUBY SINCE NINETEEN SIXTYONE.

ON DECEMBER FOUR, INSTANT, TOM NAZZIE PLAS ADVISED SA ALLEN R. BOOTH THAT HE RESIDES AT THE CRYSTAL FOUNTAIN MOTEL, CARSON CITY, NEVADA, BUT IS PRESENTLY CONFINED IN JAIL, CARSON CITY. HE SAID THAT SOMETIME BETWEEN NINETEEN FIFTYTWO AND FIFTYFOUR HE RESIDED IN DALLAS, TEXAS FOR A YEAR TO A YEAR AND A HALF AND DURING THIS TIME FREQUENTED THE SILVER SPUR CLUB WHICH WAS OWNED BY JACK RUBY. RUBY SUBSEQUENTLY GAVE HIM A JOB AS OVERSEER OR MANAGER OF THE CLUB. HE SAID HE ONLY WORKED THERE FOR THREE OR FOUR WEEKS. HE SAID THAT DURING THAT TIME HE WAS ARRESTED BY THE DALLAS POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR POSSESSION OF A FIREARM AND BLACKJACK, BOTH OF WHICH BELONGED TO THE CLUB OR TO RUBY.

PLAS LEFT DALLAS ON TERMINATION OF HIS EMPLOYMENT BUT AGAIN SAW RUBY IN MAY, NINETEEN SIXTY TWO WHEN HE, PLAS, WAS THROUGH DALLAS AND VISITED WITH RUBY AT THE CAROUSEL CLUB FOR A FEW MINUTES. HE SAID HE HAD NEVER HEARD
