[MICHAEL F. HENEGHAN, CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER,] FAMILY COURT  
 OF COOK COUNTY, CONTACTED BY SA HERBERT F. BRIICK EIGHT SIX LAST.

[HENEGHAN] STATED THAT ACCORDING TO INSTRUCTIONS RECEIVED BY HIM  
 FROM [EDWARD J. NERAD, CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER,] FCCC, HE  
 IS MAKING AVAILABLE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION OBTAINED FROM THE  
 LEGAL FILES OF THE COOK COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT CLERK'S OFFICE, WHICH  
 RELATES TO SUBJECT RUBY AND HIS BROTHERS AND SISTERS.

[HENEGHAN] STATED THAT JACOB RUBINSTEIN, LEGAL RECORDS,  
 CASE DOCKET NUMBER NINE ZERO THREE FOUR TWO, REFLECTS HE APPEARED  
 IN JUVENILE COURT, CHICAGO, ON DEPENDENCY HEARING, JULY TEN  
 TWENTY THREE, AND THAT THIS WAS THE FIRST TIME HIS NAME APPEARED  
 IN COURT RECORDS. THE PETITION WHICH HAD BEEN FILED, WAS TO

THE EFFECT THAT RUBENSTEIN, AGE SEVENTEEN, HAD NOT HAD PROPER PARENTAL CARE. AT THE TIME HE WAS IN CUSTODY OF HIS MOTHER, FANNIE RUBENSTEIN, THREE SIX FOUR SEVEN ROOSEVELT ROAD. HIS FATHER, JOSEPH RUBENSTEIN WAS RESIDING AT ONE TWO FIVE ZERO SOUTH MORGAN. JUDGE H. STERLING POMEROY MADE A FINDING OF DEPENDENCY AND APPOINTED THE JEWISH HOME FINDING SOCIETY PAREN JHFS ENPAREN GUARDIAN WITH THE RIGHT TO PLACE. THE CHILD/S FATHER WAS ORDERED TO PAY THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOUR DOLLARS PER WEEK TO BE DRAWN BY THE JHFS. ON NOVEMBER TWENTYONE, TWENTYFOUR, MICHAEL W. CAGNEY PAREN POSSIBLY A CASE WORKER ENPAREN ASKED THAT THE CASE BE REOPENED. A REHEARING BEFORE JUDGE VICTOR P. ARNOLD WAS HELD NOVEMBER TWENTYFOUR, TWENTY FOUR. AT THE SAME TIME A SECOND DEPENDENCY PETITION WAS FILED REQUESTING THAT JACOB KEPECS WHO HAD BECOME SUPERINTENDENT OF THE JHFS AS HAVING CUSTODY. JUDGE ARNOLD VACATED ALL PREVIOUS ORDERS AND SET THEM ASIDE. HE CONTINUED THE HEARING ON THE NEW PETITION TO DECEMBER EIGHT, TWENTY FOUR. THE HEARING ON THE SECOND PETITION WAS FURTHER CONTINUED ON THE FOLLOWING DATES.. DECEMBER FIFTEEN

TWENTY FOUR., JANUARY THIRTEEN AND TWENTY SEVEN, TWENTY FIVE AND APRIL SEVEN, TWENTY FIVE. ON APRIL EIGHT, TWENTY FIVE, THE HEARING WAS CONTINUED QUOTE GENERALLY ENQUOTE. HENEGHAN ADVISED THAT CONTINUING THE HEARING GENERALLY MEANT THAT FOR ALL INTENS AND PURPOSES THE CASE HAD BEEN CLOSED. HE FURTHER STATED THE EFFECT OF THE ACTION ON NOVEMBER TWENTY FOUR, TWENTY FOUR WOULD HAVE BEEN TO RETURN THE CHILD TO ITS PARENTS.

THERE WAS NO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN THE LEGAL FILES CONCERNING JACOB RUBENSTEIN HENEGHAN STATED.

WITH REGARD TO HYMAN RUBENSTEIN, LEGAL FILE, DOCKET CASE NUMBER SIX ZEPO ZERO ONE ONE, WHO WAS AGE FOURTEEN, ON DECEMBER TWENTY FIVE, NINETEEN FIFTEEN, HENEGHAN STATED THAT ON MAY ONE, NINETEEN SIXTEEN A DELINQUENCY PETITION WAS FILED IN JUVENILE COURT TO THE EFFECT THAT THE BOY WAS INCORRIGIBLE. HIS PARENTS WERE INDICATED AS JOE AND FANNIE RUBENSTEIN, ONE TWO THREE TWO SOUTH HOPKIN, CHICAGO. THE FINDING ON THE HEARING WAS QUOTE DELINQUENCY ENQUOTE AND HYMAN RUBENSTEIN WAS ORDERED PLACED ON PROBATION TO LIVE AT THE HOME OF HIS MOTHER WHO WAS IN

COURT THAT DAY. ON FEBRUARY FOURTEEN, NINETEEN EIGHTEEN PROBATION OFFICER LURA J. ROBIN RECOMMENDED THAT THE CHILD BE RELEASED FROM PAROLE TO LIVE AT THE DEBORAH BOYS CLUB, FIVE NINE THREE ZERO SOUTHPARK AVENUE. ON FEBRUARY TWENTY, NINETEEN EIGHTEEN JUDGE POMEROY SIGNED A PERMANENT DISCHARGE FOR HYMAN RUBENSTEIN.

WITH REGARD TO THE LEGAL RECORDS CONCERNING SAMUEL RUBENSTEIN, THE BROTHER OF JACOB, CASE DOCKET NUMBER NINE ZERO THREE FOUR ZERO., ISIDORE RUBENSTEIN, CASE DOCKET NUMBER NINE ZERO THREE FOUR THREE, AND IDA RUBENSTEIN, NINE ZERO THREE FOUR THREE, MR. HENEGHAN ADVISED THAT THEIR FILES WERE IDENTICAL IN EVERY RESEPECT BUT THEIR NAMES WITH THAT FOR JACOB RUBENSTEIN.

WITH REGARD TO EVA RUBENSTEIN, CASE DOCKET NUMBER EIGHT THREE THREE EIGHT THREE, HENEGHAN STATED THAT SHE FIRST APPEARED IN JUVENILE COURT ON SEPTEMBER TWENTYSIX, TWENTY ONE, ON A DEPENDENCY HEARING. SHE WAS INDICATED AS TWELVE YEARS OF AGE AT THE TIME AND HER FATHER, JOSEPH, RESIDED AT ONE TWO FIVE TWO SOUTH MORGAN, AND HER MOTHER, FANNY, RESIDED AT ONE ONE TWO EIGHT SOUTH MARSHFIELD. THE HEARING WAS CONTINUED TO

OCTOBER SIX, TWENTY ONE, AT WHICH TIME LUBA J. ROBIN WAS APPOINTED EVA/S GUARDIAN WITH THE RIGHT TO PLACE HER. HER FATHER WAS ORDERED TO PAY THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT THREE DOLLARS PER WEEK TO BE DRAWN BY LUBA J. ROBIN.

ON MARCH TWENTY THREE, TWENTY SIX, A RECOMMENDATION WAS MADE IN JUVENILE COURT THAT THE GUIDANCESHIP BE RELEASED AND THAT EVA RUBENSTEIN WAS TO RESIDE WITH MRS. B. ZUCKERMAN, ONE THREE THREE NINE SOUTH LAWDALE.

ON APRIL TWENTY ONE, TWENTY SIX, JUDGE ARNOLD SIGNED THE RELEASE.

[MARY LAWRENCE, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR] JUVENILE FAMILY BUREAU, ONE SOUTH FRANKLIN, ADVISED SA BRICK TWELVE SIX SIXTYTHREE THAT THE FILE CONCERNING HER ORGANIZATION/S CONTACTS WITH JACOB RUBENSTEIN, BORN APRIL TWENTY FIVE, ELEVEN, AND HIS FAMILY HAD BEEN DESTROYED BECAUSE OF AGE. SHE STATED, HOWEVER, THAT THE QUOTE MASTER FILE CARDS UNQUOTE HAD NOT BEEN DESTROYED AND THAT THEY INDICATED THAT JACOB RUBENSTEIN AS WELL AS HIS SIBLINGS, ISIDORE, IDA, AND SAMUEL HAD BEEN WARDS OF THE JEWISH HOME FINDING SOCIETY, THE PREDECESSOR ORGANIZATION TO THE JEWISH FAMILY BUREAU, FOR A SHORT TIME IN NINETEEN TWENTY TWO DASH TWENTY THREE. SHE STATED THAT HER MASTER FILE CARD CONTAINS LITTLE

INFORMATION RELATIVE TO THE RUBENSTEINS OTHER THAN THAT APPARENTLY THERE HAD BEEN A CONSIDERABLE AMOUNT OF PARENTAL DISCORD IN THE FAMILY INASMUCH AS THE MASTER FILE CARD BEARS SEVERAL NOTATIONS TO THE EFFECT THAT BETWEEN NINETEEN FIFTEEN AND TWENTY ONE, THE SUBJECTS/ FATHER, JOSEPH, HAD APPEARED IN COURT ON DISORDERLY CONDUCT, ASSAULT AND BATTERY CHARGES SOME OF WHICH APPEARED TO BE FILED BY FANNY RUBENSTEIN. MRS. LAWRENCE STATED THAT HER RECORDS ARE SO SKETCHY THAT SHE COULD MAKE NO DEFINITE STATEMENT AS TO DATES AND CAUSES FOR JOE RUBENSTEIN/S APPEARANCES IN COURT. MRS. LAWRENCE STATED THE ONLY ADDITIONAL SPECIFIC ITEM APPEARING IN HER RECORDS WAS A NOTATION THAT JACOB RUBENSTEIN HAD VISITED THE INSTITUTE FOR JUVENILE RESEARCH ON JULY SIX, TWENTY TWO, UNDER THEIR CASE NUMBER FOUR THREE SEVEN SIX. SHE STATED THAT THIS ORGANIZATION IS A STATE AGENCY DEALING WITH CHILDREN/S MENTAL PROBLEMS. SHE STATED SHE DID NOT KNOW WHAT SIGNIFICANCE THIS NOTATION HAD BUT WAS MENTIONING IT FOR WHAT IT WAS WORTH.

DR. RAYMOND E. ROBERTSON, M. D., PSYCHIATRIST AND SUPER-INTENDENT OF THE INSTITUTE FOR JUVENILE RESEARCH, NINE ZERO SEVEN SOUTH WOLCOTT, CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, ADVISED TWELVE SIX SIXTYTHREE THAT THE IJR DOES HAVE A MICRO FILM RECORD CONCERNING JACOB RUBENSTEIN. HE STATED THAT HE BRIEFLY REVIEWED THIS

RECORD AND IT APPEARS THAT RUBENSTEIN/S FILE CONTAINS APPROXIMATELY FIFTY PAGES CONTAINING VARYING AMOUNTS OF INFORMATION. HE ADVISED QUOTE OFF THE RECORD UNQUOTE IT APPEARS THAT THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN RUBENSTEIN/S RECORD <sup>C</sup>COULD BE VERY QUOTE INFORMATIVE UNQUOTE. HE STATED, HOWEVER, THAT THE RECORDS ARE CONSIDERED PRIVILEGED AND THAT HE DOES FEEL THAT HE SHOULD RELEASE THIS INFORMATION ONLY WITH RUBENSTEIN/S PERMISSION. HE STATED, HOWEVER, THE INFORMATION COULD BE MADE AVAILABLE UPON ISSUANCE OF A SUBPOENA TO HIM IF THIS WAS NECESSARY., HOWEVER, HE SUGGESTED THAT IF A RELEASE COULD BE OBTAINED FROM SUBJECT RUBENSTEIN AND MADE AVAILABLE TO HIM, THAT HE WOULD REVIEW THE FILE AND MAKE A SUMMARY OF THE INFORMATION CONTAINED THEREIN AVAILABLE TO THIS BUREAU WITHIN TWENTY FOUR HOURS OF RECEIPT OF THE RELEASE.
