THE QUOTE MASTER FILE CARDS UNQUOTE HAD NOT BEEN DESTROYED AND THAT THEY INDICATED THAT JACOB RUBENSTEIN AS WELL AS HIS SIBLINGS, ISIDORE, IDA, AND SAMUEL HAD BEEN WARDS OF THE JEWISH HOME FINDING SOCIETY, THE PREDECESSOR ORGANIZATION TO THE JEWISH FAMILY EUREAU, FOR A SHORT TIME IN NINETEEN TWENTY TWO DASH TWENTY
THREE. SHE STATED THAT HER MASTER FILE CARD CONTAINS LITTLE END PAGE FIVE

INFORMATION RELATIVE TO THE RUBENSTEINS OTHER THAN THAT APPARENTLY THERE HAD BEEN A CONSIDERABLE AMOUNT OF PARENTAL DISCORD IN THE FAMILY INASHUCH AS THE MASTER FILE CAPD BEARS SEVERAL NOTATIONS TO THE EFFECT THAT BETWEEN NINETEEN FIFTEEN AND TWENTY ONE, THE SUBJECTS/ FATHER, JOSEPH, HAD APPEARED IN COURT ON DISORDERLY CONDUCT, ASSAULT AND PATTERY CHARGES SOME OF WHICH APPEARED TO BE FILED BY FAMMY RUBENSTEIN. MRS. LAMPENCE STATED THAT HER RECORDS ARE SO SKETCHY THAT SHE COULD MAKE NO DEFINITE STATEMENT AS TO DATES AND CAUSES FOR JOE RUPENSTEIN/S APPEARANCES IN COURT. MRS. LAWRENCE STATED THE ONLY ADDITIONAL SPECIFIC ITEM APPEARING IN HER RECORDS WAS A NOTATION THAT JACOB RUPENSTEIN HAD VISITED THE INSTITUTE FOR DIVENILE RESEARCH ON JULY SIX, TWENTY TWO, UNDER THEIR CASE HUMBER FOUR TYPEE SEVEN SIX.
