Enclosed is one copy of the memorandum from the United States Information Agency, Washington, D. C., received 12/6/63 and a copy of the enclosure referred to therein.

The enclosed data relates to a visit to the United States by Krystian Barcz, a correspondent for Warsaw Radio and Television. Barcz, while in a Dallas restaurant believed to be the "Briggs" with his Dallas host identified only as "Jack", allegedly had a brief conversation with subject approximately three to four hours after the assassination of the President. Barcz's host, according to the enclosed memorandum, is acquainted with the subject.

Immediately attempt to identify "Jack" at Briggs Restaurant and interview. In event it is not possible to identify the "Jack" who hosted the visiting correspondent, identify and interview any known associates of the subject in this restaurant and thoroughly interview for all information in their possession concerning subject.
