What I am about to tell you may not be important but after hearing Rubinstein or Jack Ruby had many Friends in Los Angeles and Beverly Hills I started thinking about what happened here recently.

The people involved I do not know. I never saw them before. One is a Red haired woman and a man I believe to be Ruby, came out of the Bel Air Hotel, and across the street was a car with a man sitting watching. About 2 minutes after the man and woman left in separate cars The car across the street went thru a Boulevard stop and sped away at excessive speed. I had already obtained the license number of it. I tried to follow him but he disappeared. Two nites later a well dressed woman came to the back door of my home about 9 P. M. and I answered the bell, she was carrying a small square package she asked me if I knew if there was a lady by the name of Esther living in the area. I told her I didn't know She thanked me and left but she kept trying to look into my house through the partly open door. The morning before the president was killed a lady came to our station and said there was a man either asleep or sick in a car at the corner of Bellagio and Stone Canyon I told her I would investigate immediately I told my chief I would look into it, And he said "Wait, I'll call the Los Angeles Police first which he did and I left to investigate.

As I turned the corner from stone canyon into Bellagio I saw a man in a continental pass a large sum of money to another man who was parked on the other side of the street I jumped out of my car and went over to them and said to them I was sent here to investigate a man down -

The man in the continental said There is no one sick here and when I turned to the other man he was already in the car and sped away. I got his number and it was the same car I had checked across the street from the hotel. The Bel Air hotel is one and a half miles from Beverly hills. I am a patrolman with the Bel Air Patrol. And should you feel there is any worth to this I will be happy to talk to any one you wish to send to see me.

I have both License numbers and could show you the area this took place. I would like very much to see and picture of Ruby dressed up. Thi
