On 12/11/63 information received from Secret Service, Washington, D. C., that at 3:30 a.m. on 11/30/63 Mrs. Ann (Lyle) Moore, 8400 Drexel Lane, Cleveland, Ohio, telephone 961-2411, telephonically contacted the White House.

Mrs. Moore stated she is a white female, 37 years of age and her opening comment was "For what it is worth, I worked for Jack Ruby as a bar maid, Phenix City, Alabama, in 1945, 46 and 47." She stated Ruby was not a person one would like and advised he was always playing a "big boss."

According to Secret Service, Mrs. Moore also informed she works part-time at the Hanych Lounge, 52 Memphis Street, Cleveland. She requested she be contacted in a discreet way suggesting a telephonic contact informing she does not want her husband to know about her past.

For the information of the Cleveland Office, subject was inducted into the Air Force on 5/21/43 and discharged on 2/21/46. During 1945 and 1946 the subject was stationed in Georgia, Florida and Illinois. There is no indication subject has been in Phenix City, Alabama.

Within three days of receipt of this communication send Bureau and Dallas results of interview with Mrs. Moore. Follow with ten copies of FD-302 to Dallas.
