in 1945, 1946, and 1947. She stated Ruby was not a person one would  
like; stated he was always playing the "big boss".

Mrs. Moore said she works part-time at the Hanyoh Lounge, 52 Memphis  
St., Cleveland, Ohio. She requested that she be contacted in a discreet  
way (suggested telephoning her); said she did not want her husband to  
know about her past.
