CAMPAIGN PHOTO OF "SENATOR JOHN F. KENNEDY" TAKEN
11/2/60, AT SAN JOSE, CALIFORNIA, WITH A PLACARD
BEARING THE NAME "RUBY"

San Francisco determined that the then Senator JOHN F. KENNEDY appeared at a campaign rally at San Jose, California on 11/2/60.

On 12/13/63, ALAN PARKER, State Inheritance Tax Appraiser, 210 North 4th Street, San Jose, advised SA WILLIAM N. KIDWELL, JR. that he was associated with the California State Democratic Committee at the time of the aforementioned rally. Mr. PARKER was in charge of this rally. He recalled that he and his staff expected a crowd of three to four thousand. However, approximately twenty thousand persons were actually present. Mr. PARKER also informed regarding the KENNEDY placard which appears in a photograph taken by Associated Press on the occasion of this rally and bearing the name "RUBY". Mr. PARKER advised that there is no doubt
