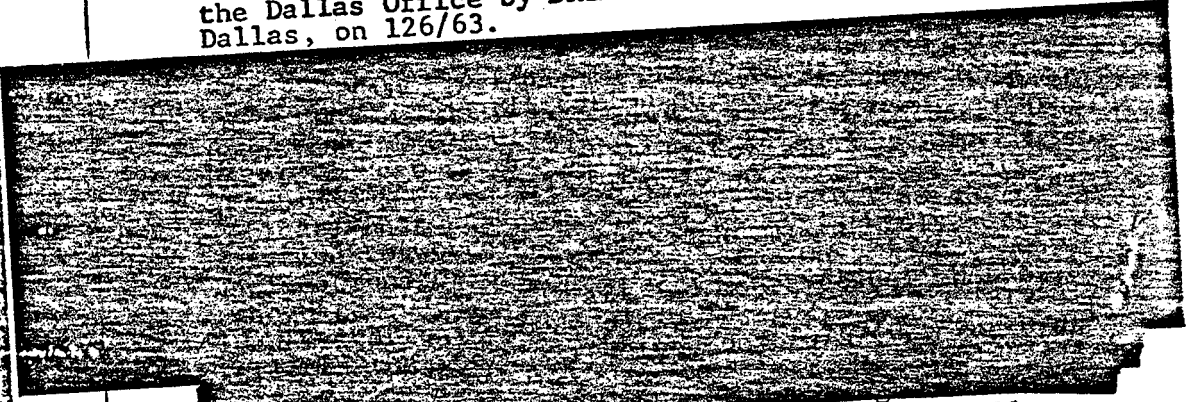

Mrs. TINSLEY advised her nephew mentioned to her on one occasion that he had gone to the Carousel Club, but she does not recall that he elaborated on this visit. She does not know whether he visited the club on other occasions or whether he is acquainted with JACK RUBY.

Mrs. TINSLEY stated she does not know JACK RUBY or LEE HARVEY OSWALD and has no information concerning this case.
