HE IS A FORMER RESIDENT OF DALLAS, TEXAS, HAVING RESIDED THERE
FOR APPROXIMATELY FOURTEEN YEARS. HE LEFT DALLAS APPROXIMATELY
TWO YEARS AGO. WHILE IN DALLAS HE AND HIS WIFE USED TO GO TO THE
VEGAS CLUB, WHICH WAS OWNED BY JACK RUDY. HE MET RUDY AT THE CLUB
AT VARIOUS TIMES. HOWEVER, HE DOES NOT CONSIDER HIMSELF TO BE A
GOOD FRIEND OF RUDY-S.

HE RECALLS READING IN A DALLAS NEWSPAPER APPROXIMATELY FOUR YEARS
