TELEPHONE CALL FROM CUBA

American Telephone and Telegraph Company, 32 Avenue of the Americas, New York, New York, on 12/13/63, advised SA JAMES M. ANDERSON that a review of their records from 11/23/63 to 11/27/63 failed to disclose a record of any telephone call from Cuba to anyone named RUBENSTEIN in the United States through the New York Long Lines Office.

The only call from Cuba which they located in their records was a collect call placed at 8:15 a.m., 11/24/63, from telephone number 3782, Mantanzas, Cuba - person to person - from Dr. RUBIN - son to Dr. RUBIN - son at Peoria, Illinois, telephone 674-8733. This call was put through at 7:00 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, and lasted for 19 minutes. *Font*

The spelling, Dr. RUBIN *Font* sons, is taken from the telephone toll ticket written out by the operator handling the above call. *Cuba*

Chicago teletype to the Bureau, Dallas and Miami, dated 11/28/63, 9:30 a.m., reflects that a telephone call was received by Dr. RUBEN G. FONT, Peoria, Illinois, from his father, Dr. RUBEN G. FONT, who was calling from Mantanzas, Cuba, and the call was concluded at 6:25 p.m., Central Standard Time, 11/24/63.
