ReNew Orleans teletype 11/27/63, with info from E. H. WILLIAMS, Regional Director, AFL-CIO, Shreveport, Louisiana, concerning group of U. S. labor leaders who made a three-week trip to Israel in 1955. One of the group was known to WILLIAMS as a representative of the Teamsters Union by the name of JACK RUBENSTEIN. WILLIAMS stated HAROLD GIBBONS, a National Teamsters Union representative, was also in the group and was very close to RUBENSTEIN. WILLIAMS doubted RUBENSTEIN was identical with subject but desired to furnish info concerning this possibility to the FBI.

Requested interview of HAROLD GIBBONS was not conducted by WFO, as stated in WFO teletype 11/28/63, since investigation determined that no passport had been issued to subject.

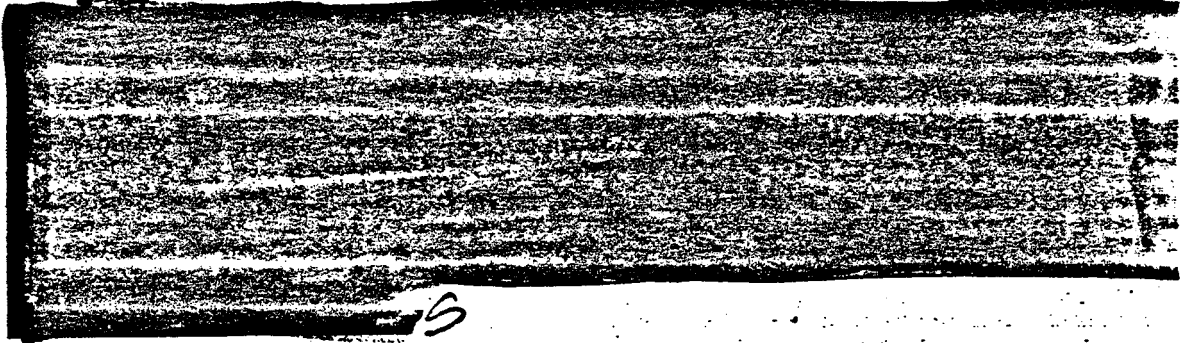
