JACK LEON RUDY, AKA/ LEE HARVEY OSWALD, AKA-VICTIM,

DECEASED, CR.

LT. GEORGE BUTLER, DALLAS POLICE DEPARTMENT, ADVISED HE HEARD RUMOR THAT JACK RUDY HAD GONE TO MEXICO AT APPROXIMATELY THE SAME TIME OSWALD WENT THERE. DIRECTOR RANGEL, MEXICAN CONSUL AT DALLAS, ADVISED THIS DATE HE HAS NO RECORD OF RUDY APPLYING IN DALLAS TO GO TO MEXICO. RANGEL POINTED OUT THERE ARE NUMEROUS CONSULATES IN TEXAS AND THAT RUDY COULD HAVE SIMPLY APPLIED FOR A TOURIST CARD AT THE BORDER.

BUREAU REQUESTED TO CHECK THROUGH THE STATE DEPARTMENT WITH THE MEXICAN EMBASSY IN WASHINGTON, D.C. AND ASCERTAIN IF ANY RECORD CAN BE LOCATED OF RUDY ATTEMPTING TO GO TO MEXICO FROM APPROXIMATELY SEPTEMBER TWENTYFIVE SIXTYTHREE TO APPROXIMATELY OCTOBER THREE SIXTYTHREE.
