In response to the points raised by the Bureau the
following comments are offered on each of the items in
question:

1. Re allegation by ELI SCHULMAN that RUBY made
trips to Hot Springs, Arkansas, with Dallas Chief of Police:

Dallas Chief of Police JESSE E. CURRY, and CARL
HANSSON, predecessor of CURRY, were interviewed and
denied allegation. Bureau refer Cover Page D, report
of SA MANNING C. CLEMENTS, Dallas, 12/11/63.

2. Re WILLIAM RICE:

Bureau refer to page 466, report of SA MANNING
C. CLEMENTS, Dallas, 12/14/63. RICE denied
knowledge of RUBY.

3. Re BILL JENKINS, JOHN L. GEORGE, JR. and DICK
MC GRUDER, reported associates of RUBY:

Bureau refer pages 404-406, report of SA MANNING
C. CLEMENTS, Dallas, 12/14/63, for information re
JENKINS and GEORGE. Dallas will interview MC GRUDER.

4. Re suggested reinterviews with SAM BARBEE, AUGUST DE ANGELO and MEYER R. PANITZ,

Las Vegas has been instructed to reinterview above persons in line with observations offered by Bureau.

5. Re TRAVIS KIRK.

San Francisco has been instructed to reinterview KIRK in accordance with Bureau's views.

6. Waitress at Old Spanish Trace Dining Room has been identified as JOY EVERETT. In interview, EVERETT stated met RUBY on one occasion through GEORGE SENATOR and disclaimed any knowledge of RUBY background or activities. Denied she had ever lived with a detective of Dallas Police Department. Bureau refer to page 150, report of SA MANNING C. CLEMENTS, 12/6/63.

7. Active investigation being conducted in an effort to identify "GLORIA". Waitress referred to as "MARGIE" has been identified as MARGIE NORMAN ETHIER, but latter unable to provide identity of "GLORIA".

8. Re Dallas Police Department Detective JOHN TONEY:

TONEY interviewed 12/12/63, and advised arrested RUBY in February, 1963, on basis of complaint made by DON TABON following assault of TABON by RUBY at Burgundy Room, Adolphus Hotel. Acknowledged subsequent contact with TABON, but denied suggestion that TABON drop charges. Stated in call, advised TABON charge could only be filed as simple assault as RUBY used fists and not weapon. TABON requested charge be filed and TONEY filed same.

TONEY admitted has known RUBY since 1952, but denied ever worked for him. Stated was off duty and out of city weekend of 11/23, 24/63.
