NAGLE was hospitalized and NIEMAN conducted an investigation.

The assassination of President KENNEDY and subsequent murder by JACK RUBY caused FIEMAN to recall the incident. He believes that RUBY was working at/or Manager of the Colonial Club at the time of above intident and that this club's present name is the Carousel Club.

NAGLE is presently Commander, U. S. Navy, assigned Office of the Comptroller of the Navy, Washington, D.C.
