The 1962 City Directory for San Francisco lists MELVIN M. BELLI, wife, JOY T., residing 1228 Montgomery St. San Francisco.

Since announcement that BELLI would defend subject, numerous articles have appeared in San Francisco daily newspapers concerning BELLI. None of these articles contain information of significance or not already set forth in above blind memo.
