JACK L. RUBY, AKA, LEE HARVEY OSWALD, AKA-VICTIM- DEC., CR.
 GEORGE SENATOR, RUBY-S FORMER ROOMMATE, HAS EMPLOYED ATTORNEY
 JIM MARTIN, DAVIS BLDG., DALLAS, TEXAS, WHO IS ALSO ONE OF THE DEFENSE
 ATTORNEYS FOR RUBY. MARTIN AGREED FOR INTERVIEW SENATOR ALONE FOR
 AVAILABLE BACKGROUND INFORMATION UP TO NOV. TWENTYTWO LAST. THIS
 INTERVIEW HAS BEEN CONDUCTED. SINCE SENATOR WILL PROBABLY BE
 DEFENSE WITNESS FOR RUBY, MARTIN INSISTS ANY INTERVIEW CONCERNING
 EVENTS OF NOV. TWENTYTWO THROUGH TWENTYFOUR LAST WILL HAVE TO BE
 CONDUCTED IN MARTIN-S PRESENCE, WITH THE QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS
 RECORDED BY A RECORDER.

SINCE THERE ARE CERTAIN DISCREPANCIES APPEARING IN EARLY
 ACCOUNTS GIVEN BY SENATOR AND CURTIS L. CCAFARD CONCERNING RUBY-S
 ACTIVITIES NOV. TWENTYTWO THROUGH TWENTYFOUR LAST, IT IS RECOMMENDED
 SENATOR BE REINTERVIEWED UNDER THE CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY MARTIN TO
 RESOLVE DISCREPANCIES, WHICH BRIEFLY ARE AS FOLLOWS-

CRAFARD STATED RUBY CALLED HIM ABOUT FIVE THIRTY AM, NOV. TWENTYTHREE LAST AND TOLD HIM TO MEET HIM WITH POLAROID CAMERA. SENATOR WAS WITH RUBY WHEN HE MET CRAFARD AND THEY DROVE OUT ON STEMMONS FREEWAY WHERE RUBY HAD CRAFARD TAKE THREE PHOTOS OF SIGN STATING QUOTE IMPEACH EARL WARREN UNQUOTE. THEY THEN DROVE TO WAFFLE SHOP NEAR CAROUSEL CLUB FOR COFFEE. RUBY DROPPED CRAFARD OFF AT CLUB AND RUBY SAID HE AND SENATOR WERE GOING TO LOOK AT F.O. BOY NO. SEVENTEEN FORTYFOUR, A NUMBER APPEARING ON THE QUOTE IMPEACH EARL WARREN UNQUOTE SIGN.

SENATOR HAS PREVIOUSLY ADVISED HE AND RUBY LEFT THEIR APARTMENT ABOUT FOUR THIRTY OR FIVE AM, NOV. TWENTYTHREE LAST AND WENT TO SOUTHLAND HOTEL FOR CUP OF COFFEE. THEY SPENT TEN TO FIFTEEN MINUTES AT COFFEE SHOP AND RETURNED TO APARTMENT TO GO TO BED. SENATOR OMITTED ABOVE DETAILS FURNISHED BY CRAFARD.

QUESTIONS ASKED SENATOR WILL BE PHRASED IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO AVOID FURNISHING INFORMATION TO SENATOR OR FBI ATTORNEY.
