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DALLAS, TEX On a date unrecalled, believed to be at least four years ago, a young fellow came to her apartment, which was then located at 3709 Travis, Dallas, selling memberships to the Sovereign Club.

She said that she recalls that membership to the Sovereign Club was \$120 and that she paid \$60 towards the membership but the club changed over before the fee was paid in full.

Mrs. CONNERS advised she never went to the Sovereign Club or the Carousel Club and never met JACK RUBY.

Mrs. CONNERS advised she does not recall ever having seen LRE HARVEY OSWALD prior to observing him on television after the assassination of President KENNEDY.

BARBARA (Mrs. CHARLES L. WHEMEY. 7947 Claremont DALLAS / related the following with regard to her name, Mrs. HEMBY, telephone RI 2-6293. This telephone number is that of her employer, National Life and Accident Insurance Company, First National Bank Building, Dallas. She has known JACK RUBY for about three years. She first went into the Carousel Club about three years ago and been there on two occasions; on both occasions being there with her husband. Her regular employment is as a receptionist in the National Life and Accident Insurance Company, but she occasionally work as a waitress for JACK RUBY on one or two nights a week, this being in the latter part of September, 1963, and continued until sometime about the first of October, 1963. She later saw RUBY on or about that day. . . . 

She does not know LEE HARVEY OSWALD and knew nothing about any possible association between RUBY and OSWALD. She knew of no conspiracy on the part of RUBY with anyone to kill OSWALD and did not know how RUBY got into the basement of the Police Department. She knew of no close associates of RUBY who were members of the Dallas Police Department. She said her husband CHARLES L. HEMBY was a former member of the Dallas Police Department and it was through her husband that she originally met RUBY. MAYOCLARE MONT, Daunsh

JOB HICKMAN, 4516 Cedar Springs, Dallas, Texas, was advised the name of JOB HICKMAN, not further identified, was found in a book which was the property of JACK RUBY. HICKMAN stated this is probably his name since he joined RUBY's Sovereign Cluw (now Carcusel Club) in Dallas, about four years ago, and he subsequently visited the club on two occasions. He said he met RUBY on one of his visits to to the Sovereign Club, but that is the extent of his association with RUBY. He knows nothing about RUBY's personal life on his business operations. Furthermore, he knows none of RUBY's friends or acquaintances.

HICKMAN stated he does not know LEE HARVEY OS WALD and he knew of no association between RUBY and OSWALD.

PEGGS and ALVIN ZIMMERHAN: bnp Date dictated .

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HILL advised that he recalled several years ago he had in his possession a membership card to the Soversign Club in Dallas, but does not recall how this card came into his possession. Mr. HILL was never in the Sovereign Club and never heard of JACK RUBY prior to the time he shot LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

HILL was shown a photograph of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, at which time he stated that OSWALD was unknown to him. He knew of no connection between RUBY and OSWALD.

Date December 18, 1963

JAMES SocKEY, First National Bank Building. Odessa, Texas, who is Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Key Investment Company, advised that he does not know JACK L. RUBY, has never met him, and has no knowledge of any background information regarding RUBY. He said he doesn't know of any connection between JACK L. RUBY and LEE. HARVEY OSWALD.

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Mr. KEY said that as he recalls, his name was submitted by a business acquaintance for a membership in the Sovereign Club in Dallas and this club sent him a complimentary membership. He said to the best of his recollection he was in no knowledge that RUBY connected with it. 1

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ecember 20, 1963

TED (NO MIDDLE NAME) MARKS. Apartment Number 2, Fireside Motel, advised he was employed by the American Guild of Variety Artists (AGVA), Chicago, Illinois, in 1958, and in January, 1959, was transferred by the AGVA to Dallas, Texas, to reorganize the AGVA office. He said that as a representative of AGVA he contacted the night clubs in Dallas and through these contacts met JACK RUBY in the Spring of 1959 at RUBY's Vegas Night Club in Dallas. MARKS stated RUBY also owned the Soverign Night Club

MARKS stated RUBY also owned the Soverign Night Club located on Commerce Street in Dallas (now the Carosel Club) and that he (MARKS) stayed to work for RUBY some time in September or October, 1960, selling memberships for the Soverign.

MARKS said he found it hard to sell memberships to the Soverign Club primarily because of the number of other clubs in Dallas who were doing the stopped working for RUBY. At the Jazz Limited Night Club and that RUBY often visited this club to review the acts MARKS had working for him in this club.

MARKS said he was never close to RUBY as a friend and had no social contacts with RUBY. He said he did not know if RUBY was married and believed RUBY lived at the Soverign Club. He said he once heard RUBY say that he had once lived in Chicago.

MARKS advised he never discussed politics with RUBY and did not know RUBY's business contacts. He said he heard <u>TEX</u> RUBY on several occasions refer to <u>BARNEY</u> and <u>ABE\_WEINSTEIN</u>, owners of two successful night clubs in Dallas, and say that he was going to get entertainers for his club in spite of the WEINSTEINS. He said he never heard the WEINSTEINS mention RUBY.

MARKS described RUBY as a "rough character", good, but one who could get mad easily and if he got mad at a customer; for example, would physically throw the person he was mad at out of the club.

Mill Valley, California SF 44-494 SAB RALPH M. LINDSEY and DALE F. NORTON:mep 12/20/63 Date dictated

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MARKS said he had no information as to any close contacts RUBY might have had at the Dallas Police Department and was surprised when he read in the newpapers that RUBY was a "hanger on" at the police department. MARKS said RUBY was a "name dropper" and recalled that when he had coffee on occasions at the Eatwell Restaurant, a restaurant which stayed open after midnight in Dallas, that he often heard RUBY talk with policeman who came in for coffee and call them by their first names.

MARKS advised he did not know LEE HARVEY OSWALD and did not know if RUBY was acquainted with OSWALD.

MARKS stated he left Dallas in August, 1962, for Californ and has had no contact with RUBY since.

TEVERAL BUREAU UP THYS

WILLIAM C./ MUELLER, 3534 Flaxey, Dallas, Texas, was advised that the name "WILLIAM C. MUELLER," was found in a book which was the property of JACK RUBY.

December 20, 1963

MUELLER advised the above name could possibly be his and as follows: explained as follows: E 1 1

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He has visited JACK RUBY's Carousel Club and Vegas Club a few times in the past, dates 'unrecalled. He stated he does not recall ever receiving a membership card to either of RUBY's clubs. He stated, however, that a friend of his, BOBBY DARRELL MARTIN, who resides in Irving, Texas, address unknown, but who is employed at Samuel Bingham's Manufacturing Company in Dallas may have given MUELLER's name to RUBY's club as a potential member. He added that MARTIN has patronized RUBY's clubs frequently in the past. a go unit 👘 55 r htt

MUELLER advised he has never met JACK RUBY and knows nothing about him. He also advised he did not know LEE HARVEY is OSWALD, and could furnish no information concerning him. . . net

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Date December 20

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GLORIANITZSCHE of <u>611</u> South <u>3rd Street</u>, was advised that she did not have to make a statement, that any statement she did made could be used against her in a court of law, and that she had the right to consult with an attorney prior to making any statements. She advised as follows:

NITZSCHE, after being advised that the name GLORIA NITZSCHE appeared in a book of JACK RUBY's, advised that she had never heard of JACK RUBY prior to the events of past month and stated that she has no idea as to how RUBY could have obtained her name. She did stated that some years ago, she did receive a circular soliciting her membership in the Sovereign Club. She did not join this club and she had no idea that JACK RUBY was connected with this club or organization.

She knew of no relation that existed between RUBY, and OSWALD or any of the organizations to which RUBY may have belonged or any close connection that RUBY had with the Dallas Police Department or anything of RUBY's travels. She knew of no conspiracy between RUBY and any other individual to kill OSWALD.

<u>Midlothian, Texas</u>

KENNETH P.

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KENNETH J. RICH, 2601 Hudnall was advised that his name appeared on a list of members of one of JACK RUBY's clubs and he was asked for available information concerning Mr. RUBY. Mr. RICH advised that he formerly operated the Kenneth Rich Investments at 211 North Ervay in Dallas. He recalls having investments at 211 North Ervay in Dallas. He recalls having met JACK RUBY only on one occasion. At that time he was handing out cards to his club, which Mr. RICH believed was called the Sovereign Club. He has had no opportunity to observe RUBY's activities or associates. He has never known LEE HARVEY OSWALD and has no information to indicate a connection between OSWALD and the Ξ and RUBY.

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HOWARD E. ROBERTS, <u>6127 Gaston Street</u> Sales <u>Manager for Parko Mat Manufacturing Company</u>, 2000 South Akard, telephone HA. 1-7657, advised he was an honorary member of the Sovereign Club operated by JACK RUBY.

He stated that Mr. HOUSTOW NICHOLS, <u>President</u> of <u>Parko Mat Manufacturing Company</u>, owned the building on Commerce Street in Dallas that housed RUBY's club. As a result, RUBY visited NICHOLS' office and gave out honorary memberships. He believes he may have visited the Sovereign Club on several occasions, however, was not personally acquainted with RUBY. He last visited this club two or three years ago and understands it is now out of business.

Mr. ROBERTS stated he can furnish no information as to JACK RUBY's current activities, having not seen him in several years. He does not personally know LEE HARVEY OSWALD and does not know if RUBY was acquainted with him. He could offer no information as to any connection or conspiracy between RUBY and the Dallas Police Department and has no personal knowledge of the shooting of OSWALD by RUBY.

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ERNEST FASt. CHARLES, <u>Statler-Hilton Pharmacy</u>, 221 St. Paul, <u>Dallas, Texas</u>, whose name was listed in a book of JACK RUBY's, advised that a few years ago he paid JACK RUBY \$15 for membership in the Sovereign Club. He actually did this just to assist RUBY in getting organized. He never used the membership card and was never in the Sovereign Club or the Carousel Club.

RUBY would occasionally come by the Statler-Hilton Pharmacy for a cup of coffee and would talk to him briefly. He did not get well enough acquainted with RUBY to furnish pertinent information concerning his activites or associates.

Mr. ST. CHARLES advised he did not know LEE HARVEY OSWALD and had no information to indicate a connection between RUBY and OSWALD. FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIC

JOHN SAZAMA, JR., M.D. (<u>Radiologist</u>), home address 1051 Waterford Drive, office 915 St. Joseph, was interviewed in connection with his membership in one of JACK RUBY's club. He related the following:

DALLAS, JEY. Two or three years ago, someone sold a membership in the Sovereign Club for \$450. He could not recall who the individual was, but was certain it was not JACK RUBY, because he has never made the acquaintance of JACK RUBY. After purchasing the membership, he went to the Sovereign Club on one or two occasions. JACK RUBY has never been a patient of his.

Dr. SAZAMA had never seen RUBY or LEE HARVEY OSWALD until he saw both on TV subsequent to the assassination of President KENNEDY.

He knew of no connection between OSWALD and RUBY and had no idea as to why RUBY killed OSWALD. He knew of no friends or associates of RUBY who were Dallas Policemen.

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JERRY BY STEPHENS, 6417 Oriole Drive, whose name appeared in a book which was the property of JACK RUBY, advised that he was solicited by an individual whose name he is unable to recall about three years ago to join the Sovereign Club. STEPHENS stated he joined but only made two visits to the club and was not acquainted with JACK RUBY and did not know of any connection between RUBY and LKE HARVEY OSWAID and does not recall ever seeing OSWAID prior to his murder.

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LAURELAVON FELDT, 7521 Westover, Houston, Texas. advised that during 1961, she was employed as a hostess for Braniff Airways and resided in Dallas, Texas. She stated that at that time, she had a membership in the Soverign Club located in Dallas, Texas and owned by JACK RUBY.

December 19, 1963

Miss VON FELDT stated that she went to the club on only three or four occasions and although she had seen RUBY several times, did not know him personally and never had occasion to socialize with him. A photograph of LEE HARVEY OSWALD was displayed to her, but she advised that she could not recall ever and cannot recall his name ever being mentioned there or by JACK RUBY. FD-302 (Rev. 1-25-60)

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December 20, 1963

RICHARD EDWIN/WALKER, <u>137</u> Las Flores Avenue, <u>Goodyear, Arizona</u>, advised that he was not personally acquainted with JACK L. RUBY or LEE HARVEY OSWALD; and therefore, knew absolutely nothing about them. He advised that he knew nothing about RUBY's affiliations, associates, or his character.

He advised he had patronized the Carousel Club in Dallas several times, saw JACK RUBY at the club, and therefore knew him by sight. He advised he had never met JACK RUBY. He advised he went to the Carousel Club with his cousin, JAMES R. TINSLEY, JR. and his cousin's friend, name unknown. He advised that he did not believe that his cousin or his cousin's friend knew RUBY.

He advised that he has no idea why his name, DICK WALKER, would be found in RUBY's property, unless it was through applying for a job. He advised that while he was in Dallas, he had applied for several jobs with quite a number of business establishments, and possibly RUBY owned one of them. He advised he did not believe he had applied for a job at the Carousel Club. WALKER stated he believed that if it was not through applying for a job, the name DICK WALKER found in RUBY's property must be another DICK WALKER.

WALKER advised that he left Dallas in late December, 1962 or early January, 1963. He advised he last visited the Carousel Club in December, 1962.

WALKER reiterated that he did not know JACK RUBY or LEE HARVEY OSWALD, and had no information whatsoever concerning them.

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The following investigation was conducted by SA RALPH E. RAWLINGS:

### AT DALLAS, TEXAS

The name JACK WATERS, with no further identifying data, appears in a list of members of the Sovereign Club, formerly operated by JACK RUBY.

WATERS: The following investigation failed to identify JACK

On December 20, 1963, JACK C./WATERS, JR., <u>4338</u> <u>Rawlins</u> advised he did not know RUBY and was never a member; of the Sovereign Club. He advised that his father, <u>JACK C.</u> <u>WATERS, SR.</u>, was a bus driver, presently out of town, but he knows his father never frequented night clubs and was never a member of the Sovereign Club.

On December 21, 1963, JACKIE L. WATERS, <u>3314 Shelby</u>, advised he did not know RUBY and was never a member of the Sovereign Club. Telephone and City Directories, Dallas, reflected no other JACK WATERS.

BIRDIE SUE BELCHER, Retail Merchants Association; J. H. KITCHING, Sheriff's Office and PATRICIA SIWIEC, Dallas Police Department, Records Bureau, on December 20, 1963, unable to furnish any information of assistance in identifying JACK WATERS. FD-302 (Rev. 3-3-59)

MARIEWEAVER, whose married name is now Mrs. GUY H. TIJAMS, 334 Ewing Street, Dallas, Texas, furnished the following information:

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Mrs. IJAMS is employed by Maher Bros., Inc., 301 Ewing, as a bookkeeper. She recalled that she had been at the Carousel Club on two occasions, but had never been a member of the Carousel Club. To the best of her recollection, she was at the Carousel Club in mid 1962, at which time she was in the company of girl friends. She recalled that she had signed a guest register before entering the Carousel Club. Subsequently, she received mail from the Carousel Club offering her membership in the club. However, she never did join the club.

She does not know JACK RUBY and never did know LEE HARVEY OSWALD, and has no knowledge of any acquaintance between OSWALD and RUBY.

ZABLE, Attorney, 3945 Travis, whose name, appeared in a book which was the property of JACK RUBY, after being advised that he did not have to make any statement, that any statement he made could be used against him in a court of law, and that he had the right to consult an attorney before making any statement, furnished the following information:

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He stated that he was a former member of the Sovereign Club, joining some three years ago. He did not personally knew JACK RUBY, although he knew of him due to the fact that he resides in the close proximity of the Vegas Club. He has no idea as to the last time he saw JACK RUBY. He did not know LEE HARVEY OSWALD and had never observed RUBY and OSWALD together. He did not know anything of RUBY's travels or of any organizations that RUBY may have been associated with. He knew of no connection between JACK RUBY and the Dallas Police Department or of any conspiracy between JACK RUBY and any other individual(s) to kill OSWALD.

DAVID HASTEPHENS, 4500 Cedar Springs Road, whose name was found in a book which was the property of JACK RUBY, advised that he visited the Sovereign Club on one occasion in about 1960 on the recommendation of a friend. He recalls he was given a membership application for the club but does not recall if he completed this application. He stated he does not know JACK RUBY or LEE HARVEY OSWALD and does not know of any connection between these two individuals.

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LARRY/READ, 4141 Glenwick, Apartment 4, was advised that a license number ND 7348, secured from a note pad which was the property of JACK RUBY had been identified as being listed in his name on a 1953 Cadillac four door. He advised that he visited the Vegas Club about one year ago but has never met JACK RUBY or made any other visits to any of RUBY's clubs and does not know how RUBY obtained his license number. He advised he did not know of any connection between JACK RUBY and LKE HARVEY OSWALD.

ETHEL CUNNINGHAM, 1082 Fair Meadow Circle, Dunkenville, Texas, was advised that license number ND 7348 was secured from a note pad which was the property of JACK RUBY and that this number had been identified as being listed in her name to a 1956 Ford four door. Mrs. CUNNINGHAN advised ahe has never had any connection or association with JACK RUBY; does not know how he obtained her license number and does not know of any connection between JACK RUBY and LEE HARVEY OSWALD.
