The following investigation was conducted by SA DARIUS L. JENKINS at Manasquan. New Jersey.

JCHN J. BAUNIGAN, 428 Euclid Avenue, advised on December 19, 1963, that he is the husband of TERESA BANNIGAN. He said she is employed in he offices of attorneys Cahill — Gordon, 70 Pine Street, New York City, working from 6:00 p.m. until about 6:00 a.m. He said she gets home at 8:00 a.m. and sleeps all day. He said his wife is a prolific letter writer and that she had written Precident KENNEDY numerous times. He said she has also written Cabinet members concerning the handling of Government policies. He said she has also corresponded with Senator CLIFFORD PACASE and Representative JAMES C. AUCHINCLOSS, of New Jersey. He said Mrs. BANNIGAN wrote leditorials for New Jersey Governor HUGHES on his current bond issue and that she had received a letter of congratulations from Governor HUGHES on the fine work she did.

He said that recently she sued the City of Manasquan and he produced an article from "The Coast Star", Manasquan paper, December, 1963, issue, which reflected "Manasquan Wins Suit - Mrs. Bannigan Loses Court Action Aimed at Upsetting Beach Rate Ordinance." This article states that Superior Court Judge J. EDWARD KNIGHT has upheld the validity of Manasquan's beach rate adopted April 16, 1962.
