The following anonymous letter postmarked 1/5/64 at St. Petersburg, Florida, has been received at the Bureau.

"Ruben shot Oswald fraid he talk to much he chicken they work toghetr hire frum California jews We here to get Martin Luthr King and Wilkson and Mayr Allan We wont miss no. Two more in Washington to get Bob Kenedy and 2 nigers then johnson if be push integratin We plege not fail or die We not fail no."

Immediately advise the Atlanta Police Department. The original of the letter has been furnished to the U. S. Secret Service in view of the threat against the President. The Attorney General and the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy have also been advised of the contents of the letter. "Mayr Allan" is apparently Ivan Allen, Mayor of Atlanta and "Wilkson" may refer to Roy Wilkins, Executive Secretary, NAACP.
