The editorial states "Page 1 of several recent editions of the World-Herald was dominated by sobering news stories: 'Governor Morrison said he would press investigation of threats against a Cozad School Board official and her family. She had resigned after an anonymous letter saying "it's too bad there is not a Lee Oswald in Cozad." The FBI also is investigating.' - - - Not all the madness in America is centered in Dallas. - - - If every reasonable person keeps his voice down he will be contributing to the restoration of a calm and agreeable climate."
