NOTE: Paul H. Smiley, a retired investigator for the VA, was interviewed as a result of a letter he directed to the Bureau indicating he had information about the Ruby case. He was interviewed by WFO on 1/10/64 and it was determined he had no direct information other than that he had read in the newspapers. In illustrating some suggestions for investigating the Ruby matter, he stated that he had attended a part held by an unidentified owner of a New York tire company during the 1920's. This individual exhibited to him a gold or gold plated badge from the Washington, D. C., Police Department which he alleged would gain him entrance to the White House at any time he desired.
