Also enclosed is a copy of a letterhead memorandum dated January 13, 1964, setting forth the results of the interview with Mabel E. Sylvester January 10, 1964, which was conducted in response to her letter.

The letterhead memorandum is furnished to you in view of her statement that she is afraid to furnish the information she has to anyone but Mr. Robert Kennedy or a member of the Kennedy family and that she will attempt to arrange the placing of this information in the proper hands.

For your information M. Sylvester, Box 131, East Lansing, Michigan, is identical with Mabel E. Sylvester who in 1962 resided at 575 North Hagadorn Street, East Lansing, Michigan, and who is known to the East Lansing Police Department. On January 3, 1964,

[redacted] advised that Sylvester was considered to be [redacted] She is in her early fifties and is employed as a real estate saleswoman in East Lansing.
