TODAY'S DALLAS TIMES HERALD CARRIES STORY REFLECTING FOLLOWING INFO REPORTEDLY QUOTING ATTY. GEN. OF STATE OF TEXAS WAGGONER CARR IN AN INTERVIEW AND IN A SPEECH DELIVERED MONDAY NIGHT TO THE BROTHERHOOD OF HIGHLAND BAPTIST CHURCH OF DALLAS. CARR STATED FBI REPORTS ON JACK RUBY WILL BE TURNED OVER TO DALLAS DIST. ATTY. HENRY WADE BY PRESIDENTIAL COMMISSION INVESTIGATING THE ASSASSINATION OF PRES. KENNEDY. LEE RANKIN, COUNSEL FOR THE COMMISSION, HAS AGREED TO TURN OVER THE DATA AT THE REQUEST OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, WHO SATURDAY GAVE THE COMMISSION ALL THE RESULTS OF THE TEXAS INVESTIGATION INTO THE ASSASSINATION AND THE KILLING OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD. DIST. ATTORNEY WILL BE FREE TO USE THE FBI DATA IN PROSECUTION OF THE ACCUSED SLAYER OF OSWALD.

ATTY. GEN. CARR STATED HE HAD NOT READ ALL THE REPORTS, BUT FROM WHAT HE HAD READ, HE HAD COME TO THESE CONCLUSIONS. OSWALD WAS A LONE RANGER AND WORKED ALONE. OSWALD WAS THE MAN WHO SHOT AT FORMER MAJ. GEN. EDWIN A. WALKER, AND THIS FACT INDICATED HE WAS NOT PART OF A CONSPIRACY BECAUSE OF THE VARIANCE IN THE
