NOTE: The President's Commission by letter dated 1-6-64 furnished a letter from a Mrs. Chadwell, Kokomo, Indiana, indicating she had heard a broadcast immediately prior to shooting of Oswald in which the announcer anticipated Ruby's presence at the scene of the shooting. Mrs. Chadwell was interviewed on 1-9-64 which interview indicated she [redacted] was not sure of what she heard. Lead set out to Dallas to identify announcer and check tapes. This is to insure prompt reply for dissemination to Commission.
