Captain O. A. JONES, Dallas Police Department, furnished a "schematic diagram of the basement parking area, City Hall, involved in the shooting of LEE HARVEY OSWALD by JACK RUBY". Attached to the drawing is a list of 99 individuals, including JACK RUBY, plus two persons identified only as "unknown Jap. reporter" and "unknown reporter". The list is described as a "key to personnel" shown on the diagram. A number is assigned to each individual on the list and a corresponding number on the diagram purports to show the location of the particular individual in the basement area at the time of the shooting.

A review of the list of individuals reflects all have been interviewed by Special Agents of the FBI with the possible exceptions of the unidentified reporters referred to above.

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AT DALLAS, TEXAS:

WICK FOWLER, Reporter, Dallas Morning News, advised SA JOHN T. MC MURRER on January 7, 1964, as follows:

On the morning of November 24, 1963, at which time LEE HARVEY OSWALD was shot at Dallas, Texas, he, WICK, was making a speech at the Marriott Motel to a group of women. He had no knowledge of activities at the police department at the time OSWALD was shot and, in particular, did not know and had not heard of any rumors that a 16-year-old high school girl reporter for a high school newspaper had been in the basement at the time of the shooting.

Date January 3, 1964

On January 3, 1964, Special Agent WILLIAM N. KIDWELL, JR., personally reviewed records maintained by the Marriage Records Department, Recorders Office, City and County of San Francisco, City Hall, Room 157. These records reveal in Book 353, Page 43, under registration number 4254, that EVA RUBENSTEIN MAGID, then residing 326 Eddy Street, San Francisco, on August 21, 1936, married FRANK GRANOVSKY, then residing Woodland Hotel, San Francisco.

MAGID was described as a white female, age 27, born in Chicago, Illinois, divorced, occupation - clerk. Her father is listed as JOSEPH RUBENSTEIN, born in Russia and her mother is listed as FANNY TUREK, born in Poland.

FRANK GRANOVSKY was described as a white male, age 30, divorced, born in Boston, Massachusetts, occupation - salesman. His father was listed as LOUIS GRANOVSKY, born in Russia and his mother is listed as SADIE PHILLIPS, born in Germany.

This information appears on Marriage License number 560 and reveals that the above individuals were married by ELLIOTT M. BURSTEIN, Rabbi, Congregation Beth Israel, San Francisco. The witnesses were listed as HUBERT BROOKER and E. B. ROSENGARTEN, both of 473 Ellis Street, San Francisco.

The above record can be produced by Deputy Recorder ANDREW F. MAISONMADE, Marriage Records Department, Officer of the Recorder, City and County of San Francisco.

The following investigation was conducted by  
SA WILLIAM N. KIDWELL, JR.:

The files of the Marriage Records Department, Office of the Recorder, City and County of San Francisco, reviewed on January 3, 1964, revealed in part that on August 21, 1936, EVA RUBENSTEIN MAGID married FRANK GRANOVSKY. GRANOVSKY's San Francisco address was given as the Woodland Hotel. This marriage was witnessed by HUBERT BROOKER and E. B. ROZENGARTEN, both of 473 Ellis Street, San Francisco. The marriage ceremony was performed at the Congregation Beth Israel, 1039 Geary Street, San Francisco.

On January 9, 1964, FLORENCE M. FRENCH, 473 Ellis Street, advised that this address was formerly the location of the Woodland Hotel. However, in approximately 1960 the building was remodeled and is presently an apartment hotel. None of the former occupants of this building were retained as tenants subsequent to 1960. Mrs. FRENCH stated that she has been a resident of the district wherein 473 Ellis Street is located for approximately 30 years and has managed or owned various hotels in this neighborhood.

She stated that the names HUBERT BROOKER, E. B. ROZENGARTEN, FRANK GRANOVSKY, FRANK GRANT and EVA MAGID are unfamiliar to her.

On January 9, 1964, CLARA PARRISE, residence address 1010 Arguello Street, Redwood City, California, advised that she formerly owned the Woodland Hotel at 473 Ellis Street. She stated that this ownership occurred during the approximate period from 1931 through 1933. She advised that the hotel was then sold to a MARTIN ANDERSON. This individual owned and managed the establishment for many years but is now deceased.

Mrs. PARRISE also advised that the names mentioned above in the interview with Mrs. FRENCH are unfamiliar to her. She was unable to suggest anyone who might presently be in the San Francisco Area who was a tenant of the aforementioned hotel in 1936.

On January 9, 1964, M. L. ROSE, Realtor, 370 Market Street, advised that his company acted as agent for the Woodland Hotel for many years during the 1930s and 1940s. The hotel has changed hands on many occasions. The only person Mr. ROSE could specifically recall as having owned the premises was one CHARLOTTE RUSSELL, now deceased. Mr. ROSE stated that he had no personal contacts with the individuals who were tenants at this establishment.

On January 9, 1964, WILLIAM C. WAYDEMAN, Manager, Arlington Hotel, 400 Ellis Street, advised that he has resided in this immediate neighborhood for approximately 35 years. He stated that he knew many of the former tenants of the Woodland Hotel. He was unable to furnish the names or locations of any of these individuals, stating that he did not know whether any of these persons were still in this neighborhood.

Mr. WAYDEMAN stated that he has read numerous newspaper articles concerning the Subject and has seen photographs of the Subject both in the newspapers and on national television. He stated he did not know the Subject during the Subject's reported residence in San Francisco.

The names mentioned in the interview with Mrs. FRENCH set forth above were unfamiliar to Mr. WAYDEMAN.

On January 9, 1964, Mrs. KATHERINE WHEELER, Room 436, Arlington Hotel, 400 Ellis Street, advised that she has resided in this neighborhood for over 25 years. She stated that she lived in the Woodland Hotel on two occasions, one of them being during the period from 1934 through 1936. She stated that she does not recall having met anyone who was a tenant in this hotel during this period who used the names mentioned in the interview with Mrs. FRENCH, above.

Except for the publicity afforded the Subject's activities in Dallas during November, 1963, Mrs. WHEELER stated the name JACK LEON RUBY was unfamiliar to her.

Mrs. WHEELER was unable to furnish the names of any other individuals who were tenants of the Woodland Hotel during the period she resided at this establishment.

On January 10, 1964, MAURICE SOULE, Owner and Manager of the Essex Hotel, 634 Ellis Street, advised that he owned and operated the Woodland Hotel during the period 1952 through 1954. He stated that the names mentioned in the interview with Mrs. FREICE above are unfamiliar to him. He was unable to furnish any further information concerning ownership of this establishment prior to 1952.

On January 10, 1964, Mrs. MARY BLUMBERG, Secretary, Congregation Beth Israel, 1039 Geary Street, advised the names EUBERT BROOKER, B. B. ROSENGARTEN, FRANK GRANOVSKY, FRANK GRAIT, and EVA MEGID GRAIT do not appear in the records of this Congregation.

There is no information identifiable with the aforementioned names in the Polk City Directories for San Francisco for the years 1935 through 1940.

There is no record of these names in the files of the San Francisco Retail Credit Association, according to Mr. FRANK J. MC AULAY, Supervisor of Files, on January 9, 1964.

There is no record identifiable with these names in the files of the Bureau of Identification, San Francisco Police Department, according to Officer WILLIAM LAIGLOIS, on January 9, 1964.

On January 6, 1964, Mrs. ROSE SOLOMON, 6206½ 11th  
Avenue, advised she is divorced from her former husband,  
ABRAHAM SOLOMON. She said she did not know of or have any  
relatives by the name of FRANK GRANOVSKY, aka  
Frank Grant.

On January 6, 1963, Mrs. ROSE L. SOLOMON, 1206  
North Hayworth, advised she did not have any relative by the  
name of FRANK GRANOVSKY, aka Frank Grant.

On January 6, 1964, inquiry at the Retail Merchants  
Credit Association, Los Angeles, was negative concerning the  
name FRANK GRANOVSKY. The records reflected reference to a  
FRANK GRANT with wife FAE, first being on record with this  
bureau in 1937. The last report in 1959 reflected that this  
FRANK GRANT resided at 7114 Cantaloupe Avenue, Van Nuys,  
California. In 1956 he was listed as having been employed as  
a property man with Paramount Studios since 1938, and was a  
property man at Warner Brothers Studios in 1959.

On January 7, 1964, inquiry in the neighborhood of  
1180 Oxford Road, San Marino, California, ascertained FRANK  
E. GRANT of that address and his wife ELIZABETH, nee PARK,  
were natives of the Los Angeles area.

On January 7, 1964, inquiry in the neighborhood of  
727 West 7th Street, Los Angeles, ascertained that FRANK E.  
GRANT of that address deals in oil properties.

Efforts were made to contact PEARL GRANT, 826 South Hobart Street, Apartment 310, on January 2, 3, 6-8, 1964, with negative results.

The following investigation was conducted by IC MILLARD T. ANDERSON:

On January 6, 1964, the records of the Bureau of Vital Statistics-Deaths of Los Angeles City and Los Angeles County were checked from 1940 to that date with negative results in any identifiable information reflecting the death of FRANK GRANOVSKY, aka Frank Grant.

The following investigation was conducted by SA WILLIAM L. BYRNE, JR.:

On January 6, 7, 1964, HOMER HILL, Payroll Records, 20th Century Fox Studios, was contacted to ascertain any information to identify and locate FRANK GRANOVSKY, aka. HILL stated he could not locate any record concerning the name of GRANOVSKY. HILL located reference to one FRANK GRANT, 7114 Cantaloupe Way, Van Nuys, California, with wife FAY. HILL stated his records reflected that GRANT had performed periodic work as a property man for several years at 20th Century Fox Studios. HILL said his register for industry-wide registration for motion picture studio employees failed to reflect any additional identifying information concerning any FRANK GRANOVSKY, aka.

On January 9, 1964, Mrs. FRANK (FAY) GRANT, 7114 Cantaloupe Way, Van Nuys, California, advised she did not know the exact location of employment of her husband, although he was presently employed with Columbia Broadcasting System (CBS) Studios in their copious complex. She stated she would have her husband contact the FBI at the earliest possible opportunity.

A search of Los Angeles indices on January 9, 1964, was negative concerning the name FRANK GRANOVSKY.

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FRANK GRANT, nee GRANOVSKY, 7114 Cantaloupe Way, Van Nuys, California, telephonically advised that he met EVA MAGID, nee RUBENSTEIN, at San Francisco, California, about 1935-1936. He said they were married shortly after he met her and they resided for one month at San Francisco. They lived together for about one month at the residence of an aunt of EVA, name unrecalled, which residence was located at the intersection of Eddy and Jones Streets, San Francisco. At that time, EVA was employed obtaining newspaper subscriptions for a San Francisco newspaper, possible the "San Francisco Journal."

FRANK met EVA's brother, JACK RUBY, at San Francisco at the time FRANK met and married EVA. GRANT believed from recollection that JACK RUBY was then employed in San Francisco selling linoleum. FRANK believed that the unknown aunt of EVA moved to either Portland, Oregon, or Seattle, Washington, about the time he and EVA were married.

FRANK and EVA then moved to Los Angeles, California, about 1936 where they resided together for only four months. At that time, EVA left FRANK and departed Los Angeles, reportedly to go to Chicago, Illinois, to obtain a divorce from FRANK. FRANK said he had no type of contact or communication with EVA or JACK RUBY until about 1939 or 1940 when EVA unexpectedly returned to the Los Angeles area. EVA then obtained a divorce from FRANK in Los Angeles at the time of her return. EVA thereafter departed the Los Angeles area and FRANK had no additional contact or communication with EVA and JACK RUBY since that time. He said he had no information that JACK RUBY had ever resided in the Los Angeles area. He did not know when RUBY departed San Francisco, or that EVA and JACK had gone to Dallas, Texas, until the time of publicity that JACK had shot LEE HARVEY OSWALD at the time of the death of former President JOHN F. KENNEDY. He said he has not received any type of contact of communication from EVA or JACK since the shooting of OSWALD.

FRANK added that he had used the name of FRANK GRANT since shortly after graduation from high school and that

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he had his name legally changed to FRANK GRANT at Los Angeles in 1949. He said he is now 58 years of age and that EVA GRANT would be approximately 56 or 57 years of age, to the best of his recollection. FRANK said that he spent three years in the U.S. Army from November 30, 1942 until September 8, 1945, at which time he received an honorable discharge. He said he married his present wife, FAY, September 8, 1942, at Los Angeles, California. He said he is presently employed as a "property man" through Local 44 of the International Association of Theatrical and Stage Employees (IATSE).

FRANK said he had never met any other family members of EVA. He said he had no information or knowledge of any connection of EVA, JACK RUBY or any other possible family members being connected with any subversive group. He said he did not know JACK RUBY well enough at the time he met and married EVA to furnish additional comments concerning RUBY. FRANK explained that he had lived with EVA for only a total of six months, approximately, at San Francisco and Los Angeles. He said that when EVA departed Los Angeles, he would only presume that she returned to Chicago, Illinois, area, possibly to reside with her parents, names unrecalled. FRANK has never had any type of contact or communication with any of her family members. FRANK said that he has never been to Dallas, Texas, and had no information concerning LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

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PEARL GRANT, nee GRANOVSKY, 826 South Hobart Street, Apartment 310, Los Angeles, phone DU 9-4640, telephonically contacted SA GEORGE A. PAINE, JR. She advised she is employed by Allen Brothers, 1509 South Figueroa, Los Angeles, phone RI 8-7181.

She stated she has a brother, FRANK GRANT, nee GRANOVSKY, address unrecalled, Van Nuys, California, who has unlisted telephone number ST 6-8666. His wife is named FAY. She said that they do not have any sister named ROSE SOLOMON, or any other sisters. She said FRANK was last known a few months ago to have been working with the Perry Mason Show and that he had also previously been employed at Paramount Studios.

She said she did not know JACK RUBY, aka., or LEE HARVEY OSWALD. She said her brother had been away from home for several years during the 1930s and she had no information that her brother had ever been married to EVA GRANT. She recalled FRANK had been married to one ETHEL MILLER during the early 1930s in Los Angeles, California. She said FRANK married his present wife, FAY, about 1940 or 1941, prior to his entrance into military service. She said she had no additional information of any connection of her brother with the JACK RUBY family.

BROWN knows of no connection between OSWALD and RUBY. He stated he knows nothing concerning RUBY's personal life or political beliefs.

CATHEY has known RUBY on a very casual basis during the past six or eight years, having met him in connection with the entertainment business. CATHEY formerly operated a booking agency and, on several occasions, attempted to book acts into RUBY's clubs.

CATHEY knows nothing concerning RUBY's personal life or his political beliefs and knows of no connection between OSWALD and RUBY.

He was never closely associated with RUBY and last saw him sometime in 1957, to the best of his knowledge. Because of this limited association, he had no knowledge of RUBY's personality, political or philosophical beliefs and could not furnish any information regarding him. He had no knowledge of LEE HARVEY OSWALD and therefore knew of no association between RUBY and OSWALD.

Mrs. CULPEPPER does not know JACK RUBY personally but has seen him around various night clubs in Dallas since about 1950, while employed at the Roundup Club, Dallas, Texas. Mrs. CULPEPPER saw RUBY quite frequently because he visited the Roundup Club frequently.

Mrs. CULPEPPER knows nothing concerning RUBY's personal life or political beliefs and knows of no connection between LEE HARVEY OSWALD and JACK RUBY.

DREER advised that LEE HARVEY OSWALD is unknown to him and he knows of no connection between RUBY and OSWALD.

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Mrs. JAN RABB EISENHAUER, 6450 Packard Drive, Dallas, Texas, furnished the following information:

Approximately three or four years ago, she met JACK RUBY at Phil's Delicatessen in Dallas. At that time, she was in the company of her mother. Mrs. EISENHAUER advised that she, at this time, cannot recall the exact circumstances when she met RUBY at Phil's Delicatessen; however, she does recall that shortly thereafter she received periodic phone calls from RUBY, wherein RUBY attempted to date her. She stated that at no time did she date him and she commented that RUBY was certainly not the type of person she would consider dating. To the best of her recollection, she last saw JACK RUBY sometime in 1959 approximately six months subsequent to her initial meeting with RUBY at Phil's Delicatessen. She advised she had never been to the Sovereign Club or Carousel Club.

Mrs. EISENHAUER advised she did not know LEE HARVEY OSWALD, nor did she have any information or knowledge regarding any acquaintanceship between OSWALD and RUBY.

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 JOSEPH FRANK FEDERICI, also known as JOE FEDERICI, JOE FREDERICA, whose name appeared on a list of names obtained from RUBY indicating possible former membership in one of RUBY's clubs, advised as follows:

FEDERICI is presently residing at 3909 Inwood, Apartment number 110, Dallas, and is moving from this residence in about ten days to return to his native state, New Jersey, with his wife. He stated he can be reached in the future in care of the Rolling F Ranch, Dilt's Corner Road, Lambertville, New Jersey. He is employed as Occupation Management Consultant by the Associated Industrial Consultants, 884 West State Street, Dallas. He has been so employed at Dallas and has been residing in Dallas since February, 1963. FEDERICI advised that he has never been a member of any of JACK RUBY's clubs but met RUBY at the Carousel Club as a customer in October, 1963. He believes that during one of the three or four occasions he was a customer at this club, RUBY wrote down his name. He added that he has never known RUBY socially but only as a customer at his club on three or four occasions and thus did not have the opportunity of becoming well acquainted with RUBY. He last saw RUBY at the end of October or early November, 1963, at the Carousel Club. He and his wife left Dallas during the early morning of November 22, 1963, to visit relatives at Providence, Rhode Island, home of his wife's people, and returned to Dallas on December 2, 1963.

FEDERICI stated he never knew LEE HARVEY OSWALD and never saw him to his knowledge. He has no information concerning the assassination of President KENNEDY or the shooting of OSWALD on the part of RUBY.

FEDERICI advised that due to the fact that he is of Italian decent and inasmuch as he presently has relatives residing in Italy, he has received considerable "kidding" by individuals who ask him if he has any connections with the "Mafia". He stated that to such questions he has on occasion jokingly stated that he is a nephew of VITO GENOVESE, allegedly a leading figure in the Mafia. He added that this has always been in jest and that he has no known relatives with any connection with the Mafia or any such group.
