SUBJECT: JACK RUBY, AKA;
LEE HARVEY OSWALD, AKA - VICTIM
CIVIL RIGHTS

AAG Miller advised this afternoon that the reports on Ruby are presently under review in the Department to determine whether there is any confidential or objectionable material which should be removed before the reports are shown to Dallas County District Attorney Wade. The review will also identify persons who have furnished information bearing on Ruby's mental condition.

As soon as the file review can be completed, Wade will be permitted to look through the reports to determine what material he considers of value to the prosecution, and the Department will then decide whether to make the material available to him and will probably give him what he wants. Upon completion of the file review, the Department will also write to Ruby's counsel, furnishing a list of names and addresses of persons who have given information bearing on Ruby's sanity.

Mr. Miller commented that if the Bureau is in a position to tell him what, if any, information should be removed from the reports before they are shown to Wade, arrangements could be immediately made for Wade to see the reports and further review by the Department in this regard would be unnecessary. Mr. Miller was advised that the Bureau would defer to the judgment of the Department as to what information should or should not be made available to Wade.

ACTION:

We will continue to follow this matter closely with the Department until it is fully resolved.
