ETTORE JOHN DE CARLO, TWO FORTY MESA ROAD, SAN YSIDRO,  
CALIFORNIA, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE RED CAB COMPANY, SAN YSIDRO,  
TELEPHONICALLY ADVISED THIS DATE, THAT HE HAD DROPPED OFF  
A PASSENGER BY THE NAME OF BOB KINSEY AT TRAILWAYS BUS DEPOT  
IN SAN YSIDRO. DE CARLO ADVISED KINSEY STATED HE WAS RECENTLY  
DISCHARGED FROM THE U.S. NAVY AND WAS ON HIS WAY HOME TO THE  
DIAMOND L RANCH, LA MARQUE, TEXAS.

DE CARLO STATED KINSEY, WHILE RIDING IN THE TAXICAB,  
DISCUSSED PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION. KINSEY TOLD  
DE CARLO HE HAD SEEN RUBY AND OSWALD AT THE CAROUSEL CLUB  
IN DALLAS, TEXAS, THE NIGHT PRIOR TO THE ASSASSINATION.  
KINSEY TOLD DE CARLO THAT HE HAD BEEN HOME ON LEAVE AT THE  
TIME OF THE ASSASSINATION.
