murder of Lee Oswald

Sir:

On November 24, 1963 at approximately 11:00AM, I was assigned by Lt. Brown to the basement hallway around the Burglary Bureau.

I was standing by the last window on the left of the jail's fence observing the people gathered there, when Oswald was brought down.

Just as soon after he was taken out the jail office door leading to the drive, I heard what sounded like a shot.


I then saw Detectives Combs, Grimes, and Lovelle attempting to get Oswald, who was down, back into the jail office.

As I attempted to assist with Oswald the rush of the others bringing in the suspect caused me into the jail office.

I then attempted to assist with Oswald but I was placed in on the public staircase.

After the ambulance left Lt. McKinney ordered me toarkland Hospital. I stood guard at the bottom of the stairs floor during the remainder of the day.
